Background

The Connecticut School Health Survey is a comprehensive survey that consists of two components: the Youth Behavior Component (YBC) and the Youth Tobacco Component (YTC). In the fall of 2013, the Youth Behavior Component of the Connecticut School Health Survey was administered to students in both Wallingford, CT high schools. The survey is developed by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and nationally, the survey is known as the Youth Risk Behavior Survey (YRBS). The 2013 version was modified by the CT Department of Public Health and the State Department of Education for statewide use. For Wallingford, it was further modified by representatives of municipal departments and community organizations.

Academic Performance

81.1% of Wallingford students describe their grades in school as mostly A's or B's during the past 12 months
