Walgreen's pharmacies have recently issued a press release that includes CT in the list of states that will allow the pharmacy chain to have a medication drop box and also distribute Narcan with a prescription at their locations.

According to Drug Enforcement at John Gadea's office (CT Department of Consumer Protection) - The Walgreen's/DEA press release is wrong. John has already been in touch with Walgreen's lobbyist. Pharmacies in CT may NOT participate and they cannot give Naloxone away without a prescription.

Legally nothing has changed in CT.
