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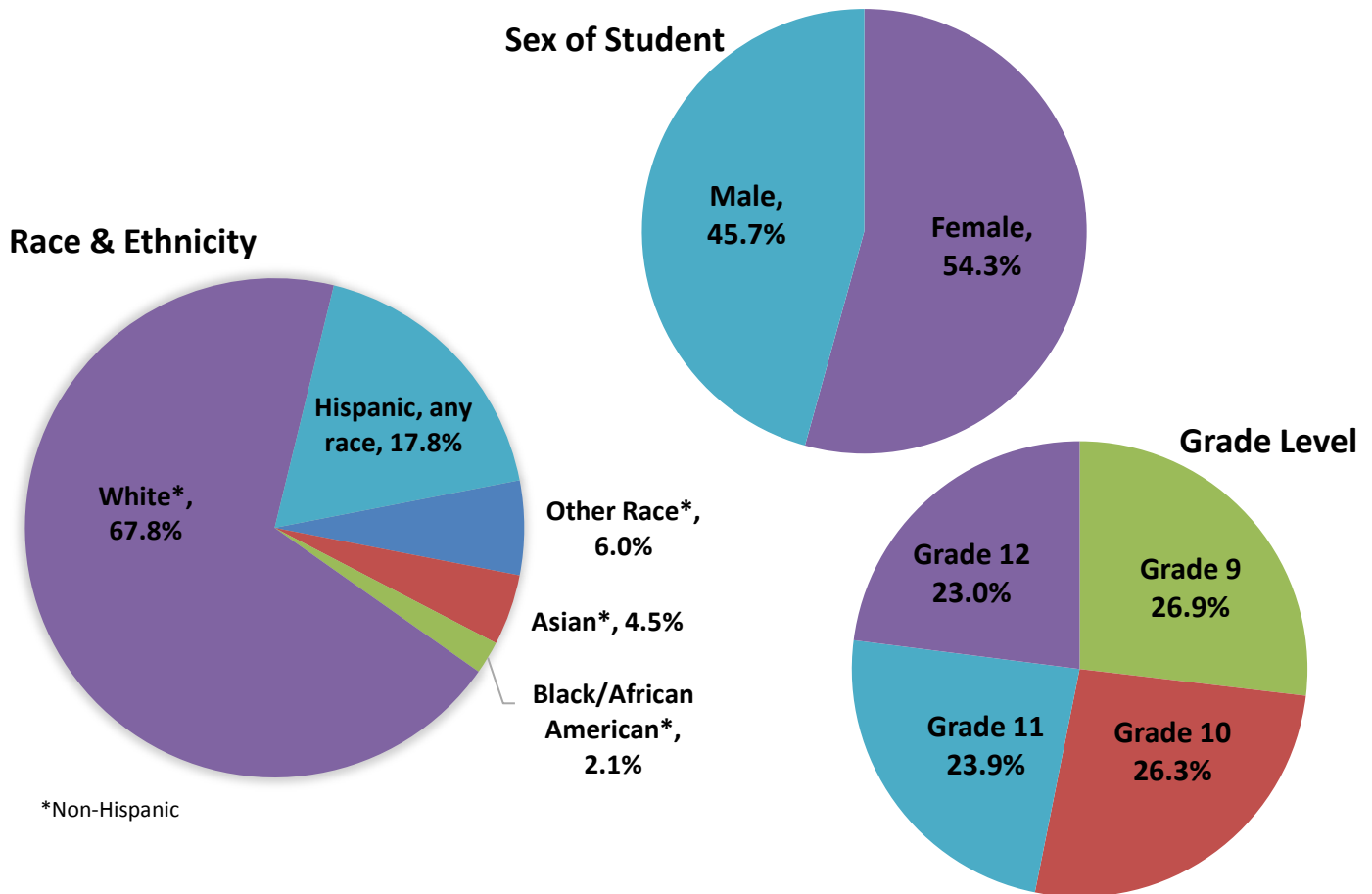
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## Survey Summary and Description

The Connecticut School Health Survey (CSHS) is a comprehensive survey that consists of two components: the Youth Behavior Component (YBC) and the Youth Tobacco Component (YTC). In the fall of 2017, the Youth Behavior Component of the Connecticut School Health Survey was administered to students in Wallingford, CT high schools. The survey was previously administered in the fall of 2015 and 2013. The survey is developed by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and nationally, the survey is known as the Youth Risk Behavior Survey (YRBS). The 2013 and 2015 versions were modified by the Connecticut Department of Public Health and the State Department of Education for statewide use. For Wallingford, it was further modified both years by representatives of municipal departments and community organizations. The version administered in 2017 was the same as the 2015 questionnaire.

In 2017, 1,697 Wallingford high school students participated in the YBC. The survey was available in English or Spanish. The overall student response rate was 86.6% (85.6% at Lyman Hall High School and 87.6% at Sheehan High School). Student non-response was attributed to parental non-consent, student non-consent, absenteeism, field trips or ineligibility (e.g., special education or english-language learners). When applicable, a comparison is provided with results from the statewide sample administered to public high schools in the spring of 2017. Trends are also presented across the 3 survey years if available.

## Academic Performance

84.7% of Wallingford students describe their grades in school as mostly A's or B's during the past 12 months.

*Comparison with Connecticut results in 2017: 73.6 - 80.9%*

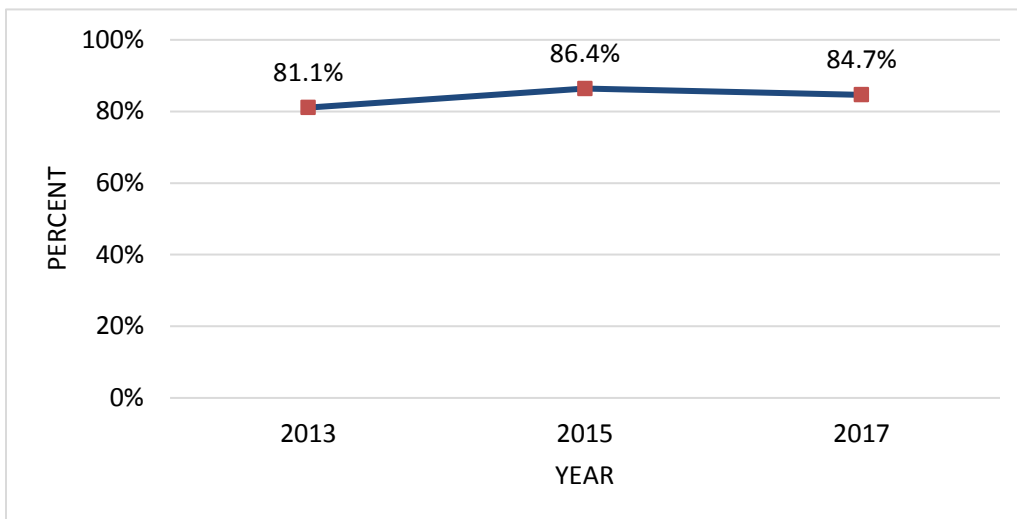

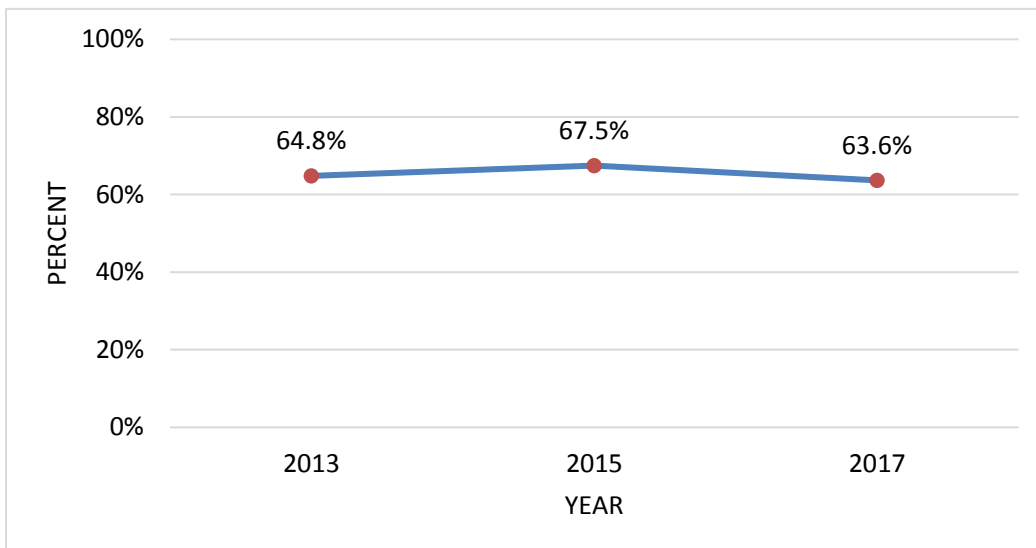

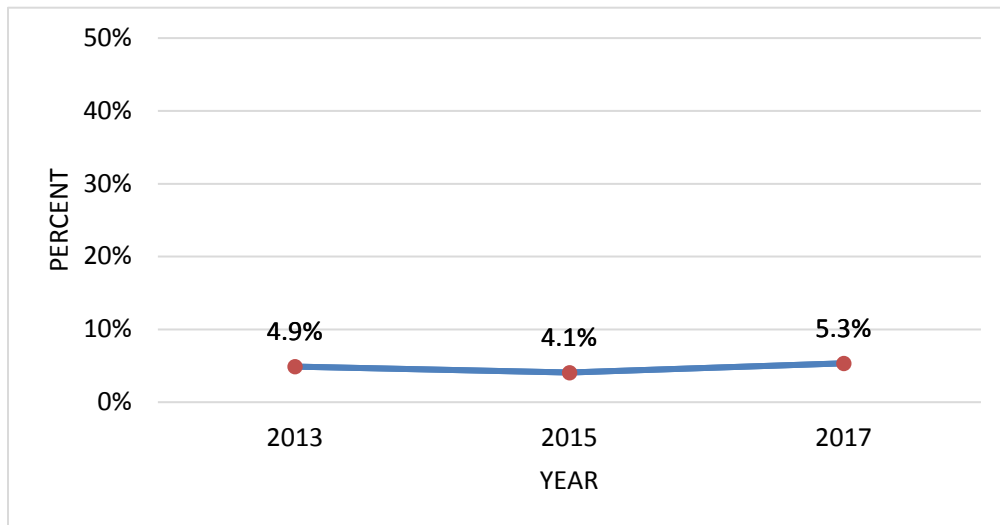

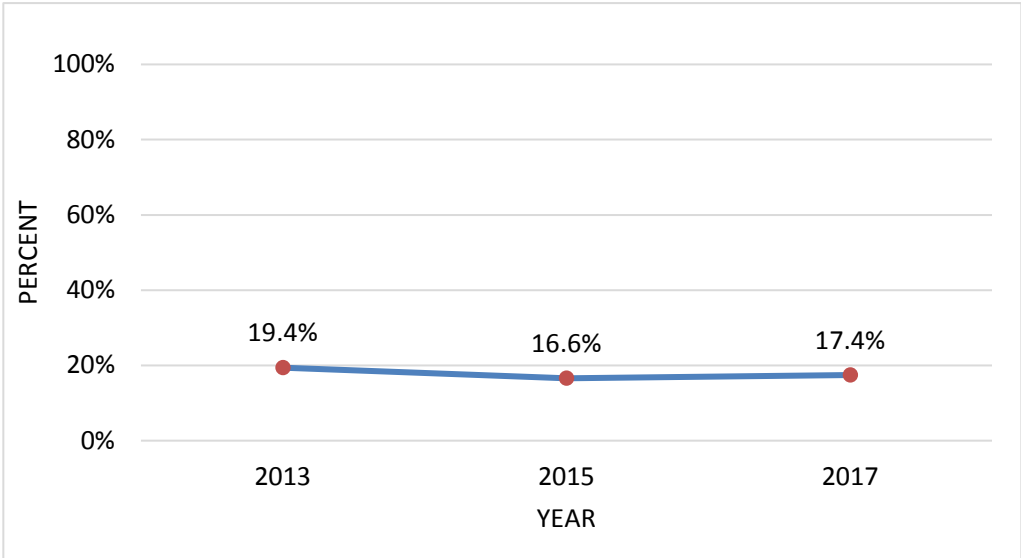

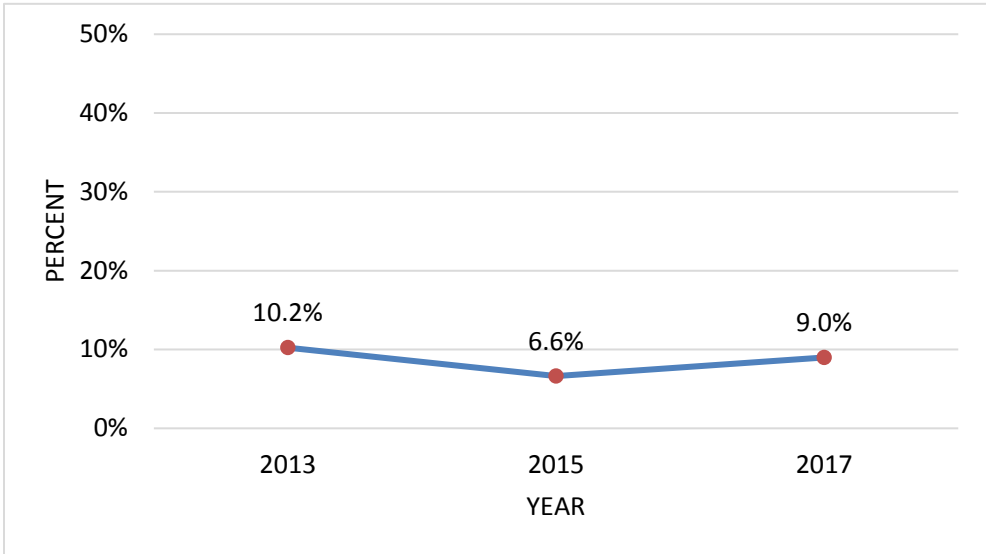

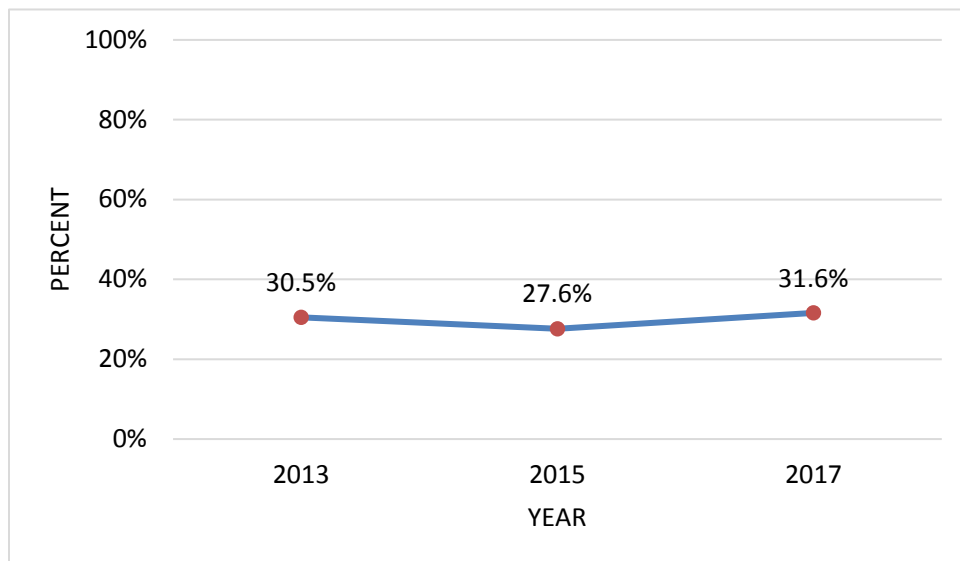

That's approximately 3 out of every 10 teen drivers.

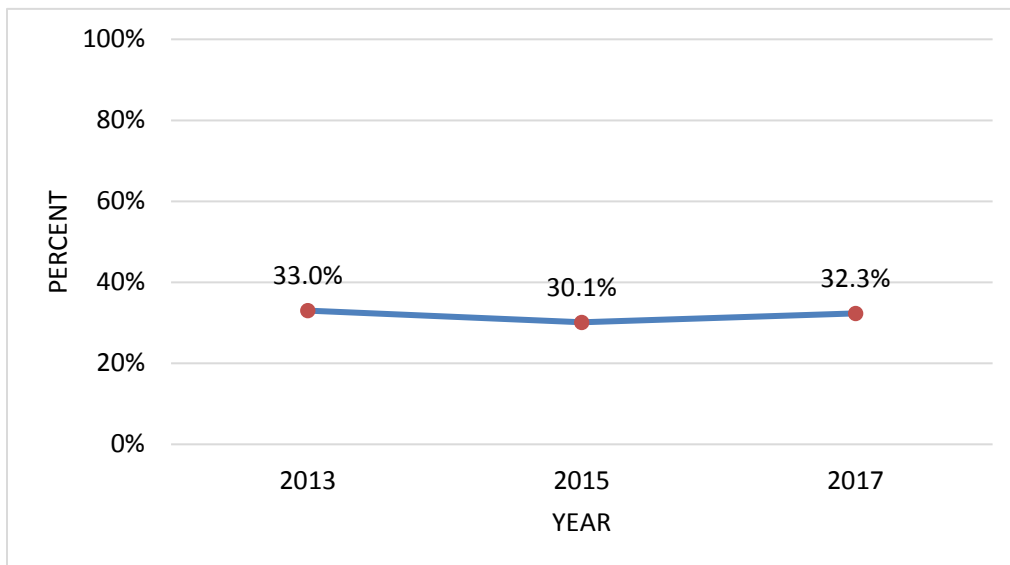

## Injury and Violence

Among those that played sports during the past 12 months, 20.4% of Wallingford students suffered a blow or jolt to their head while playing with a sports team (either during a game or during practice) which caused them to get "knocked out", have memory problems, double or blurry vision, headaches or "pressure" in the head, or nausea or vomiting.

*Comparison with Connecticut results in 2017: 14.8 - 19.0%*

That's approximately 2 out of every 10 sports team members.

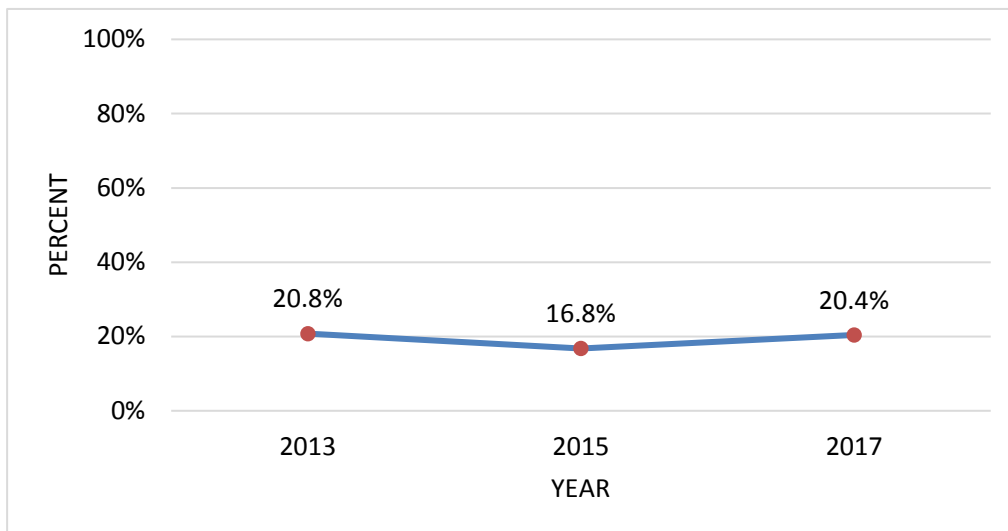

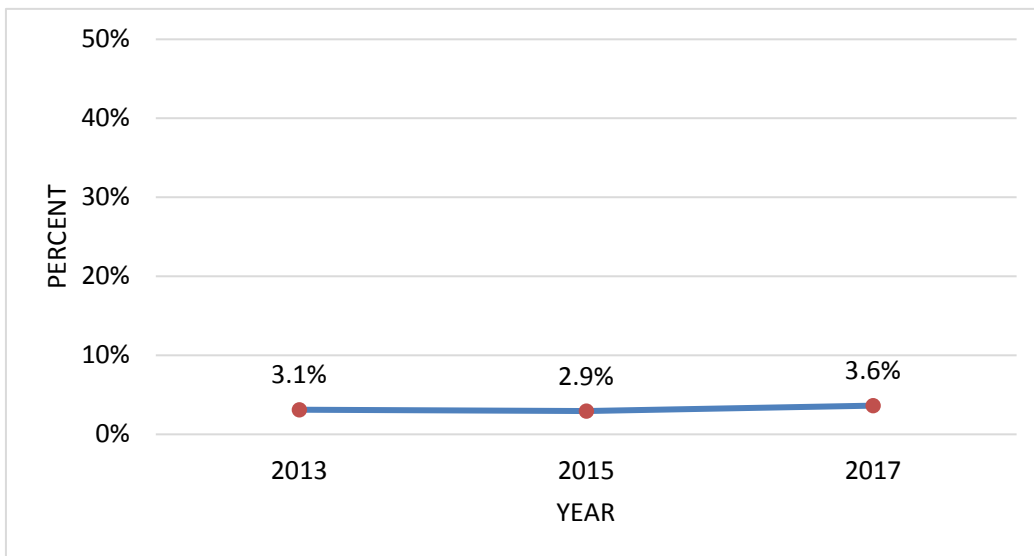

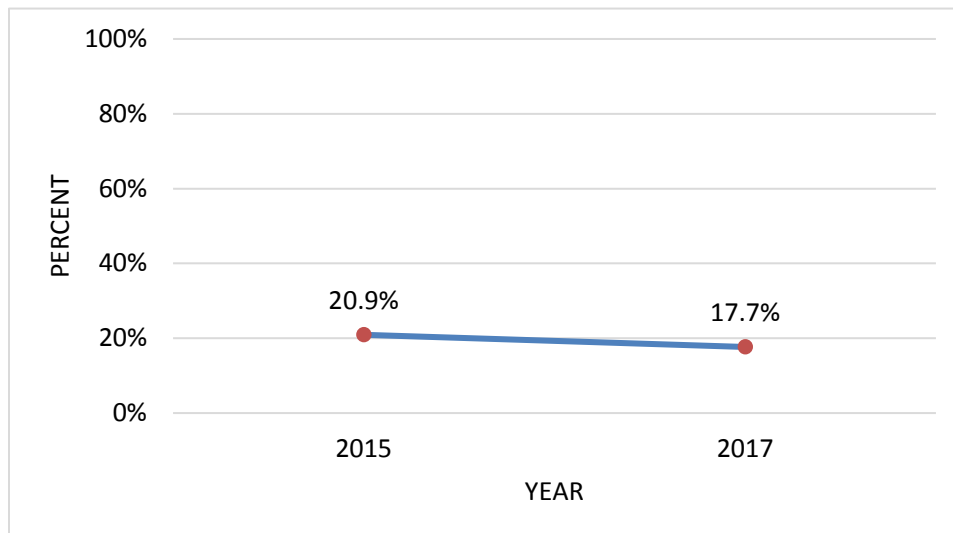

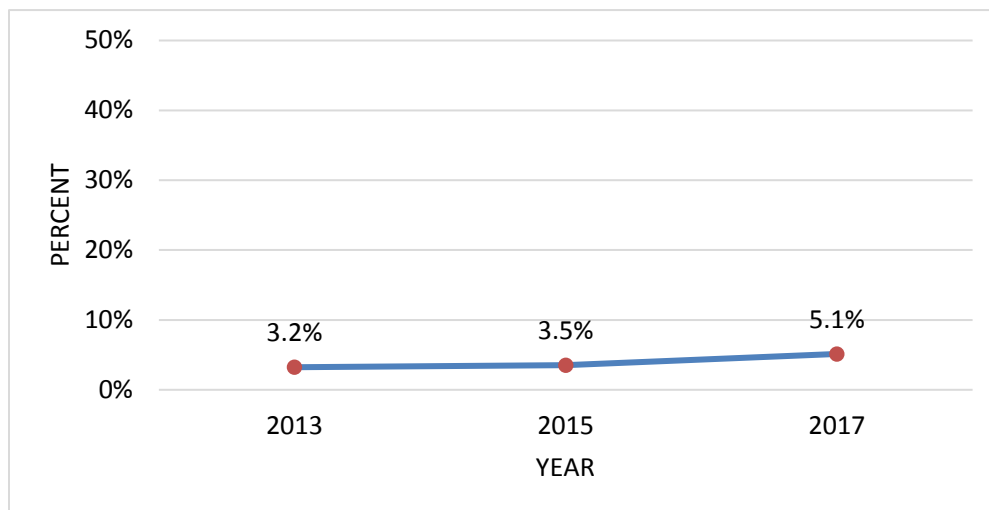

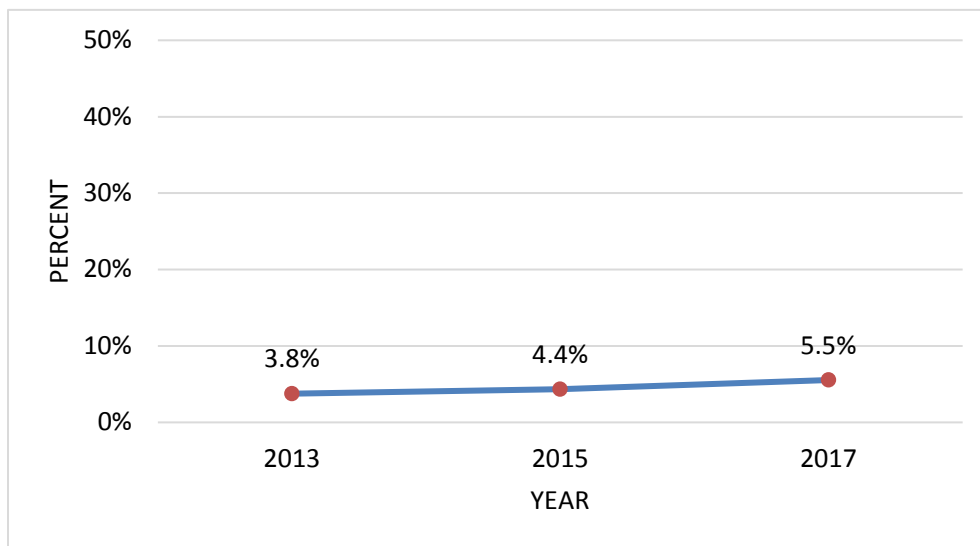

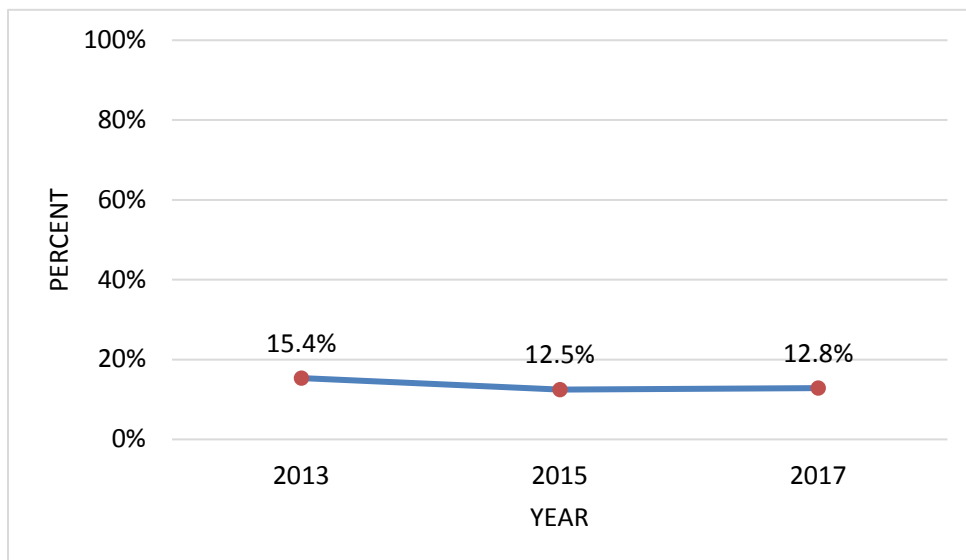

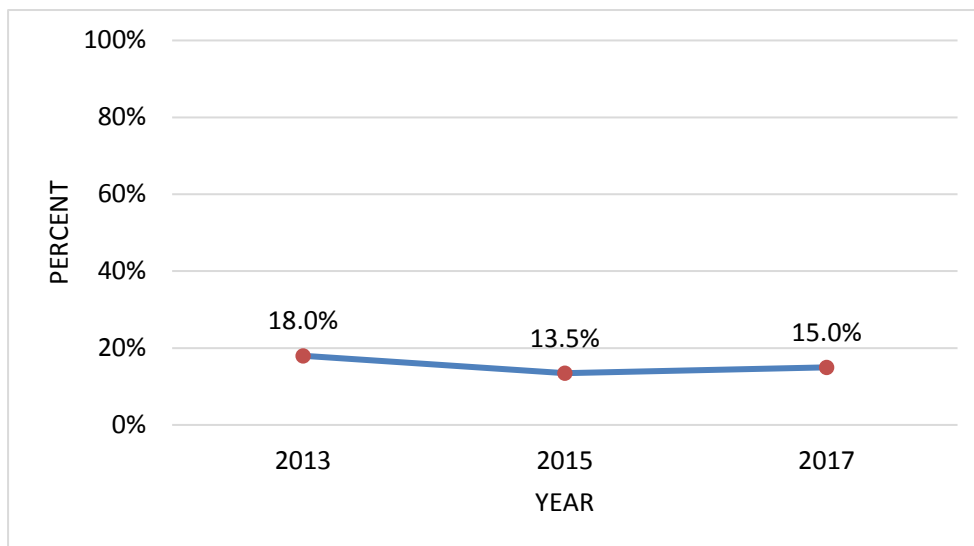

## Injury and Violence

*Comparison with Connecticut results in 2017: 20.4 - 26.5%*

That’s about 3 out of every 10 females and 2 out of every 10 males (among those who were in a dating relationship in the past year).

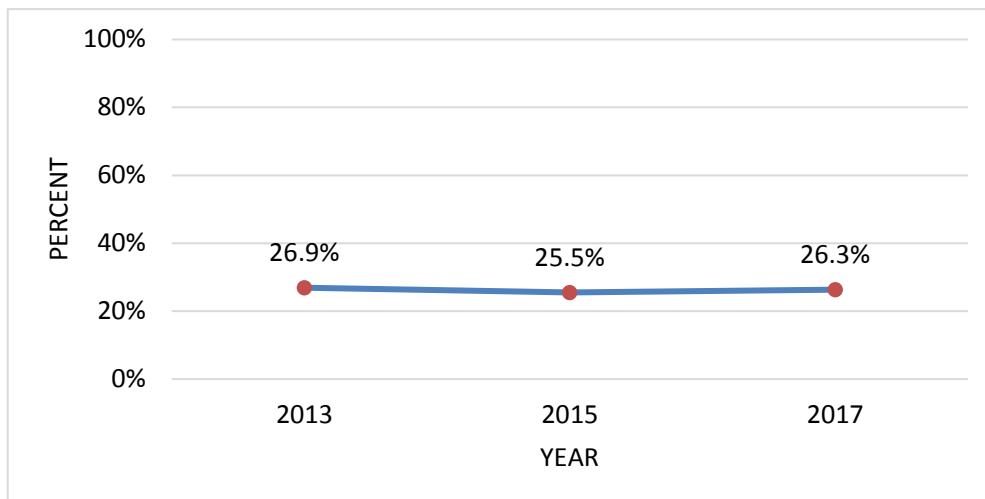

That’s about 1 out of every 12 students who were in a dating relationship in the past year.

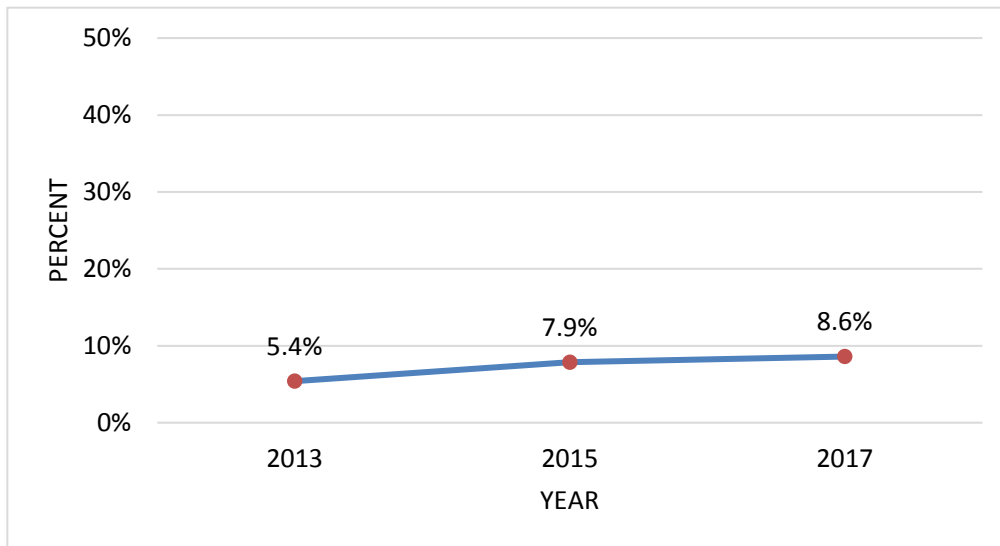

## Injury and Violence

Among those who dated someone during the past 12 months, 12.8% of Wallingford students had been forced by a boyfriend or girlfriend to do sexual things\* that they did not want to one or more times during the past 12 months.

*Comparison with Connecticut results in 2017: 8.2 - 12.2%*

That’s about 1 out of every 6 females, and 1 out of every 12 males, (among those who were in a dating relationship in the past year).

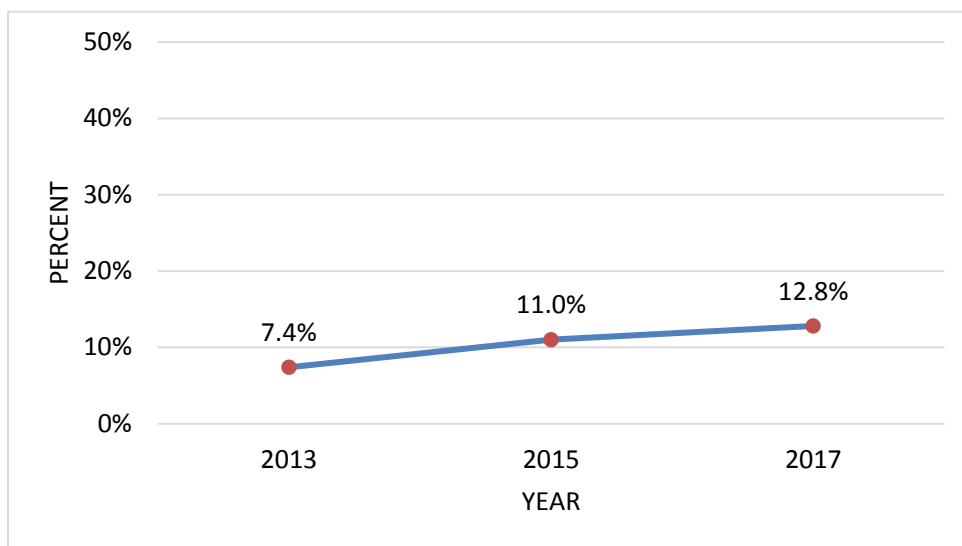

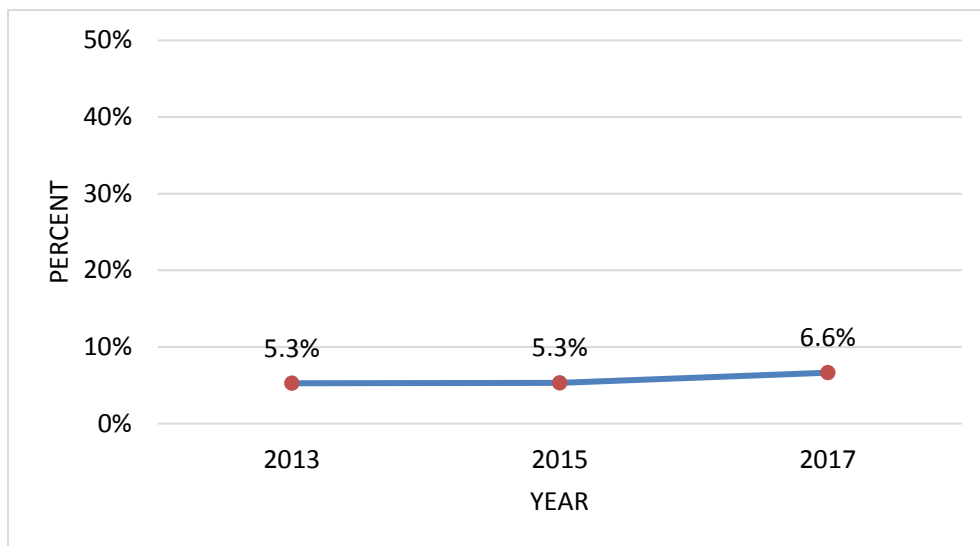

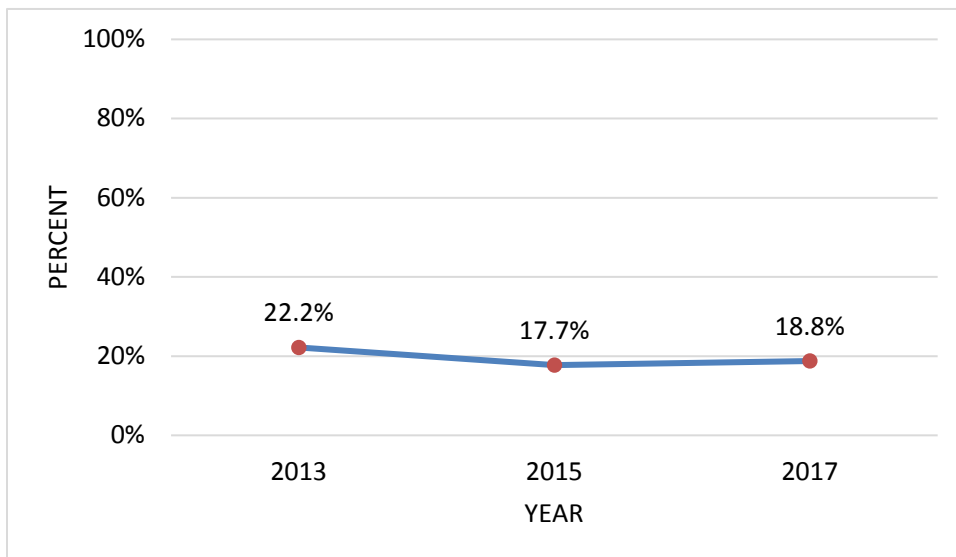

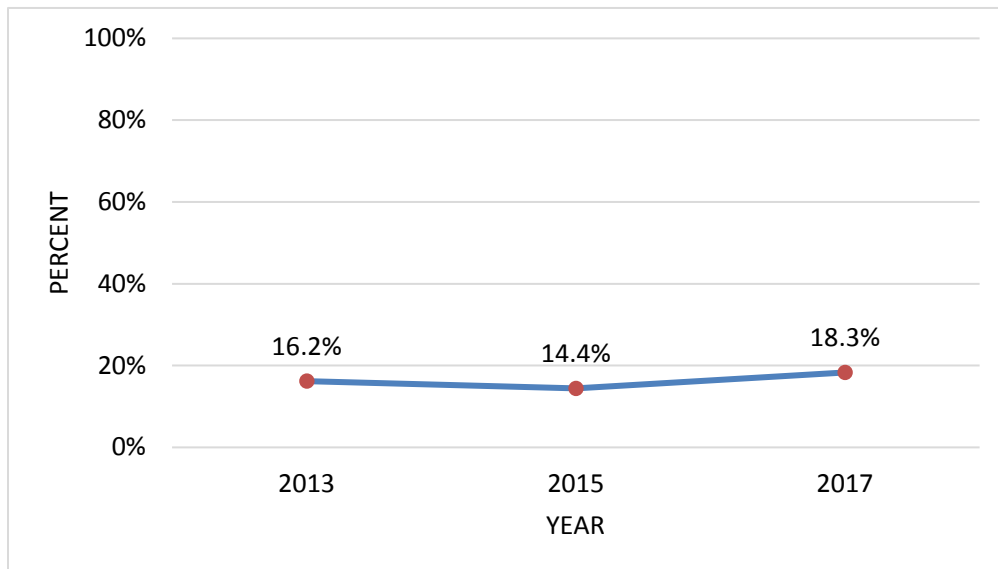

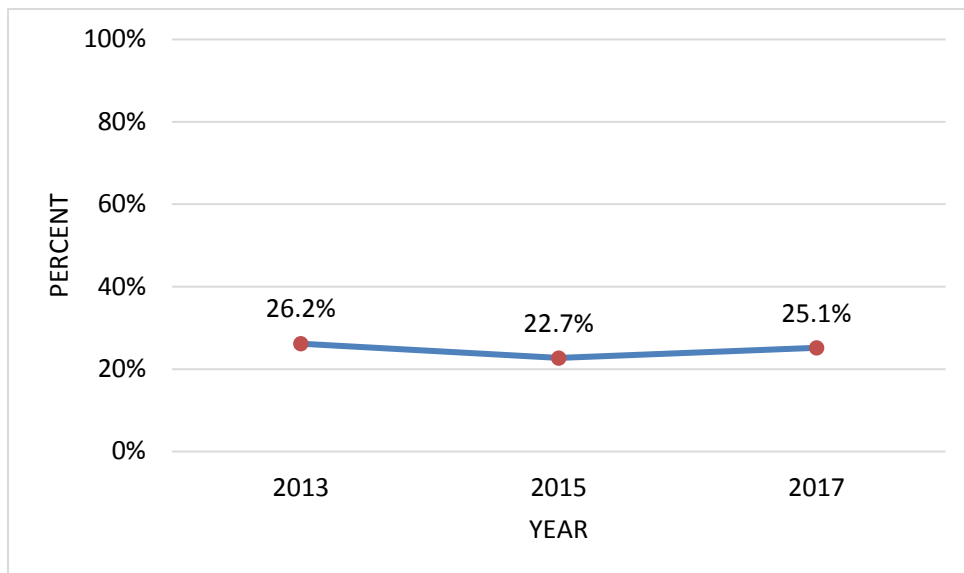

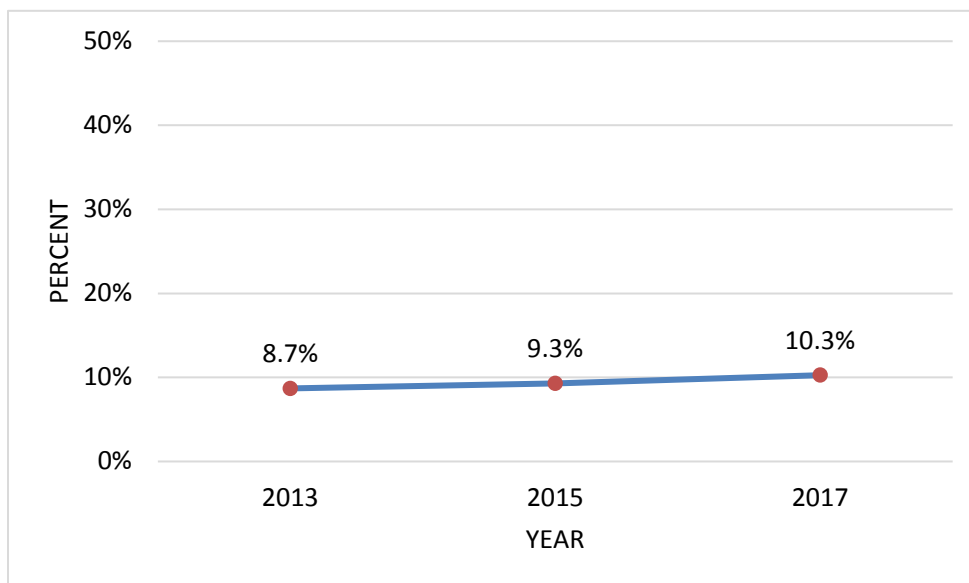

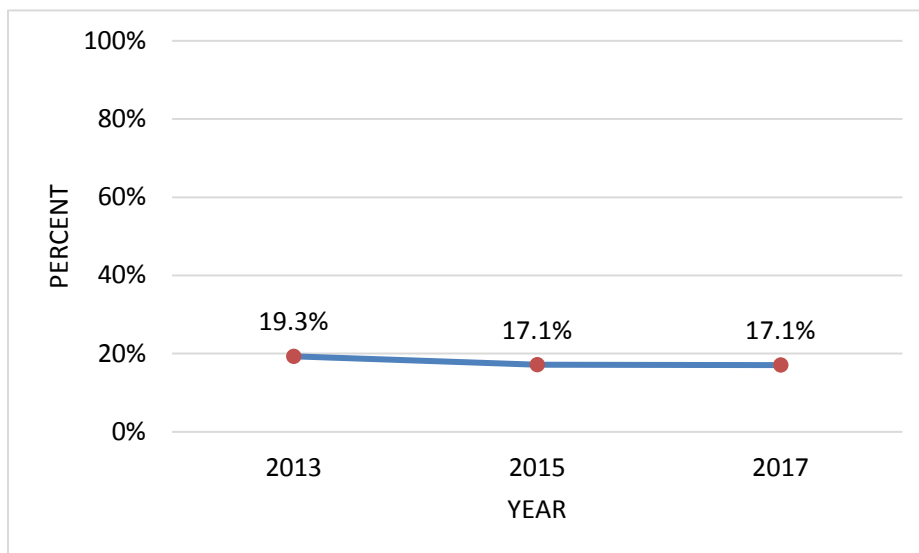

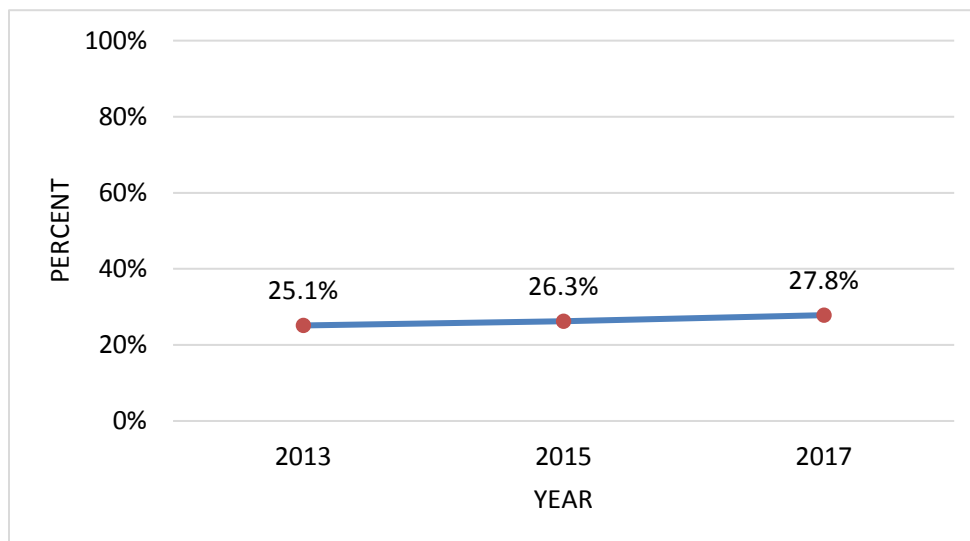

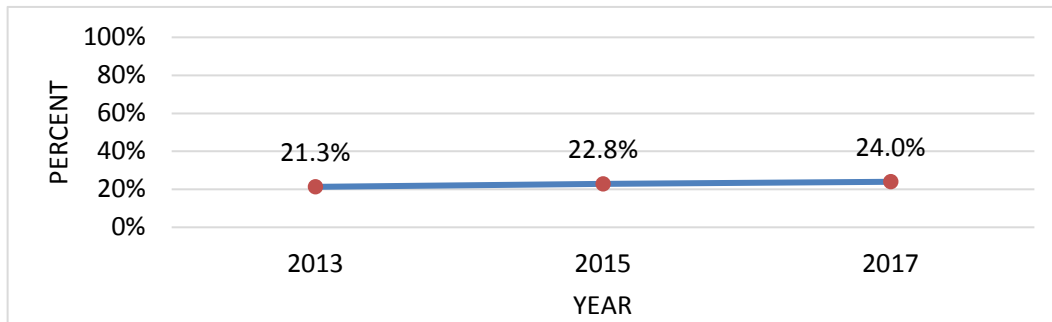

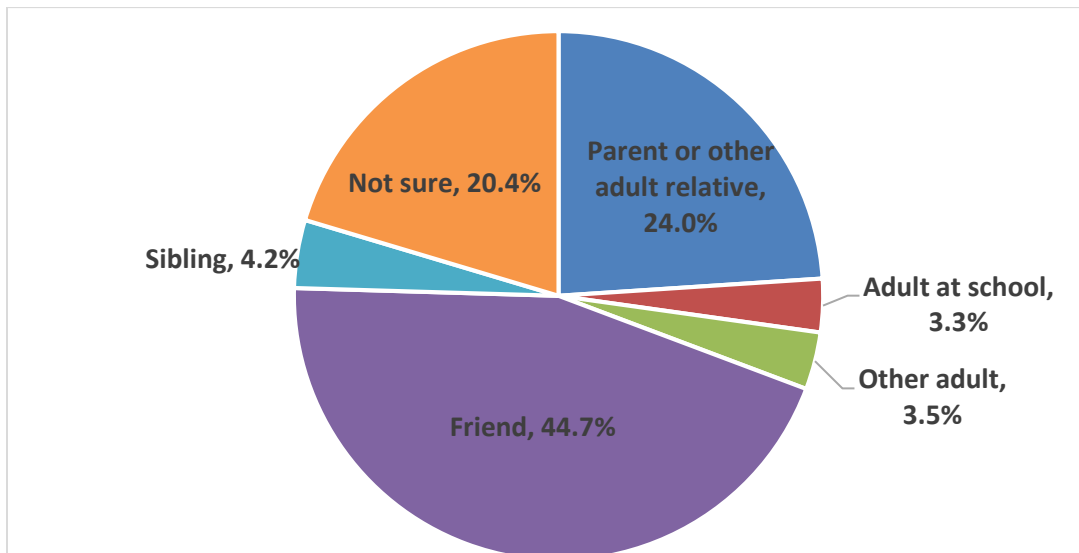

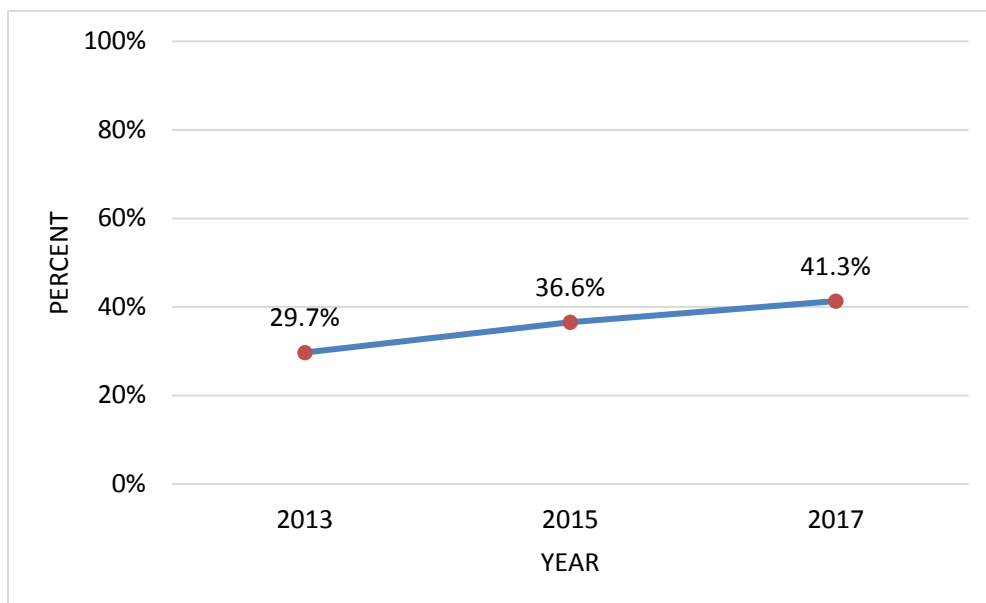

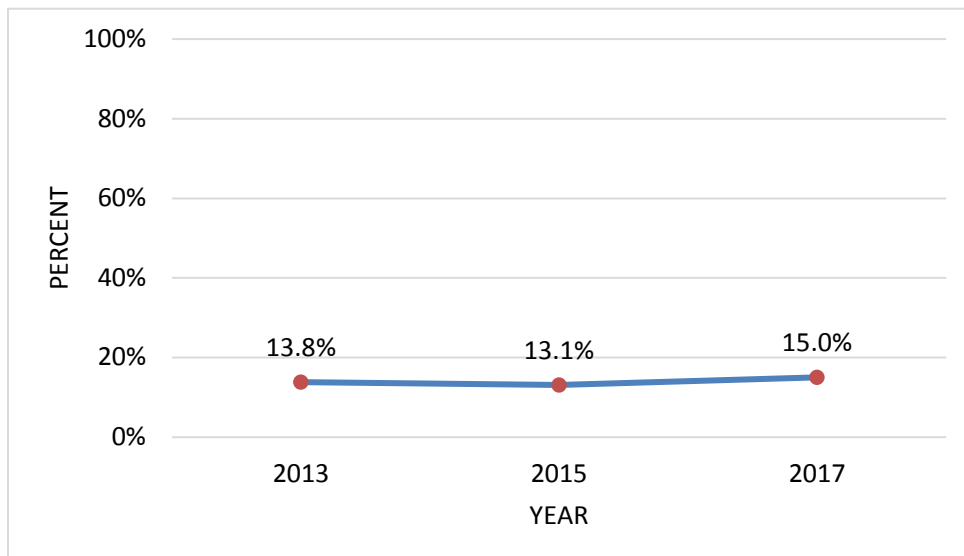

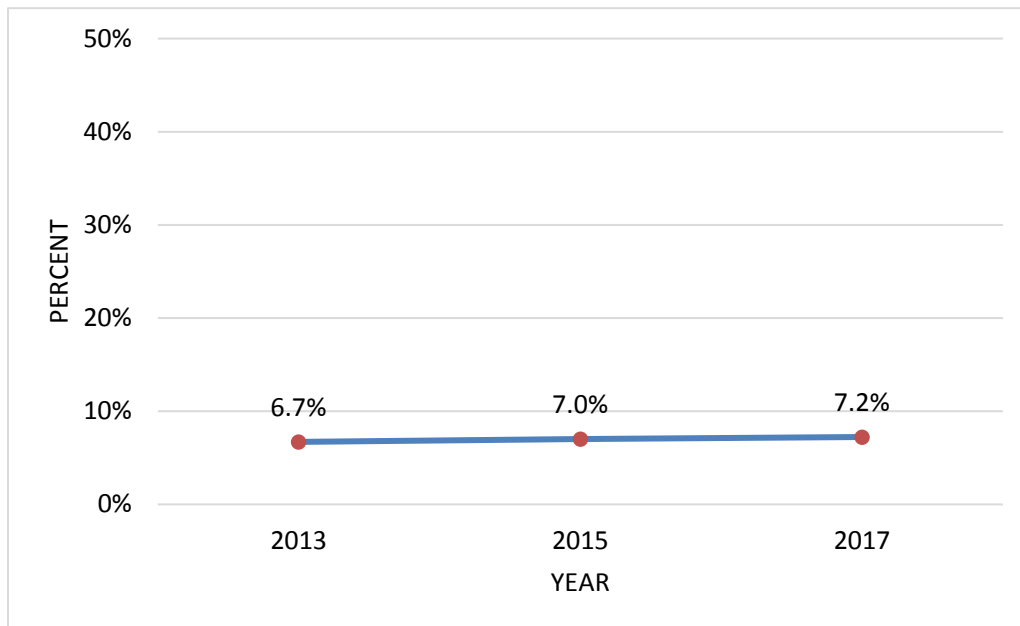

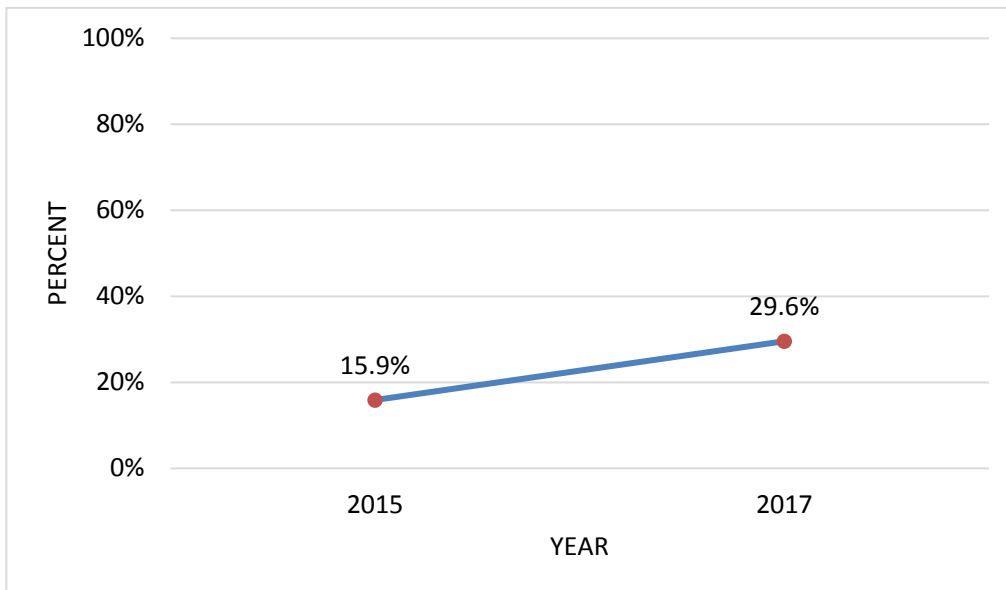

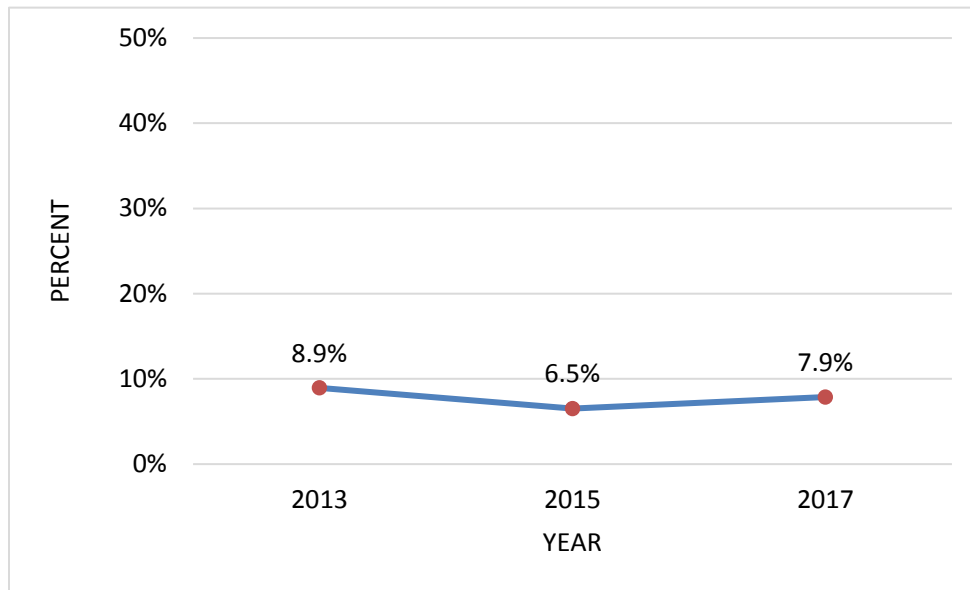

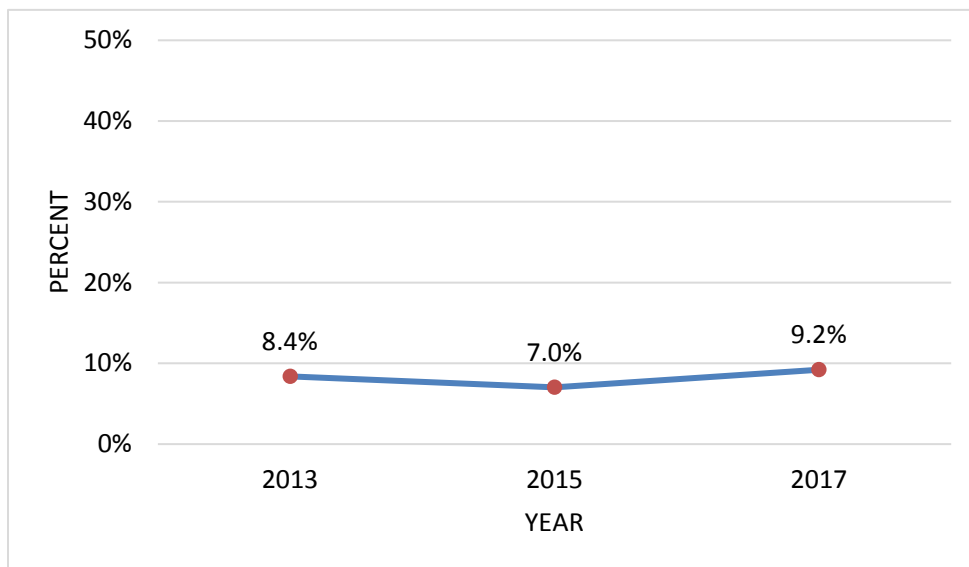

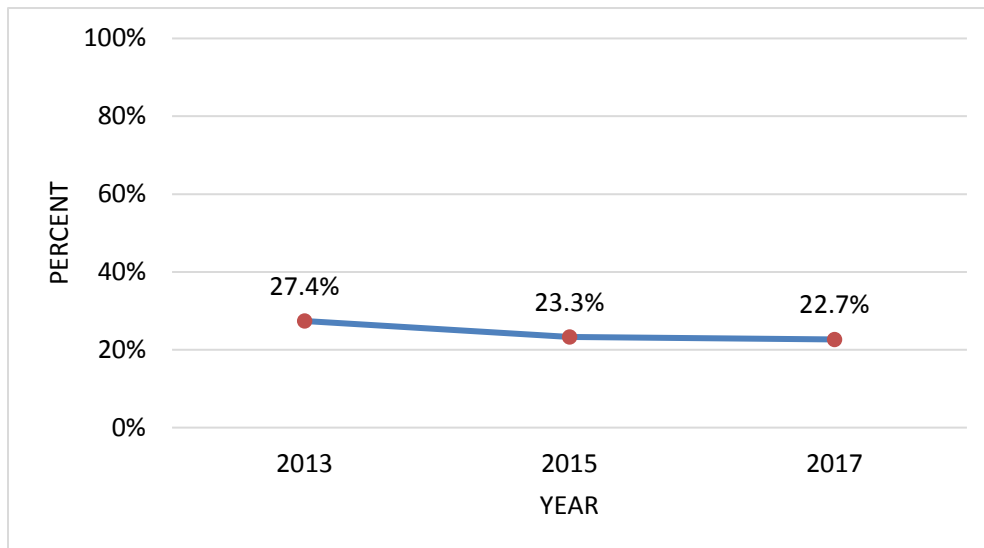

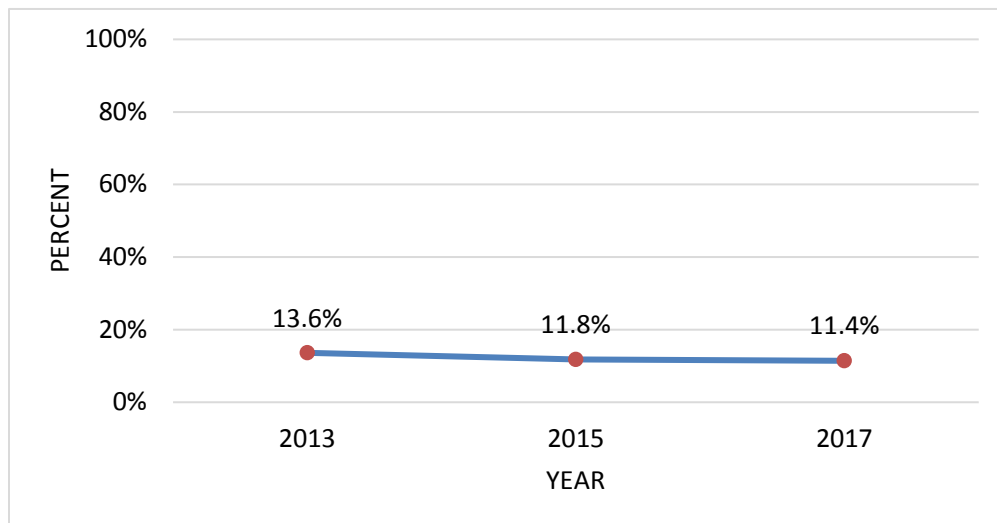

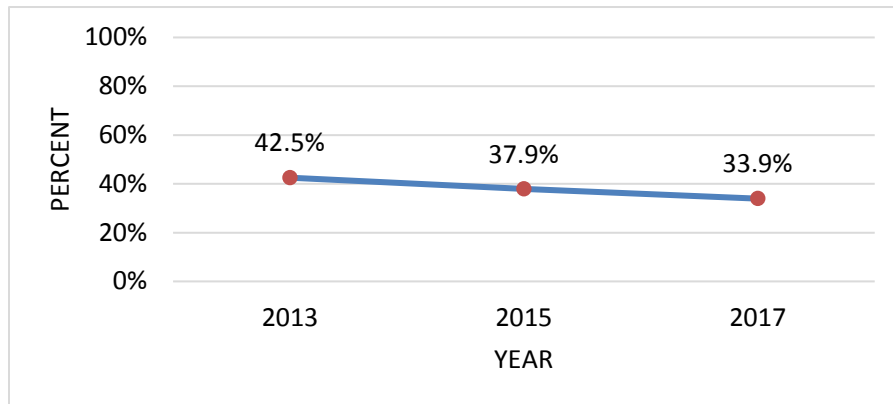

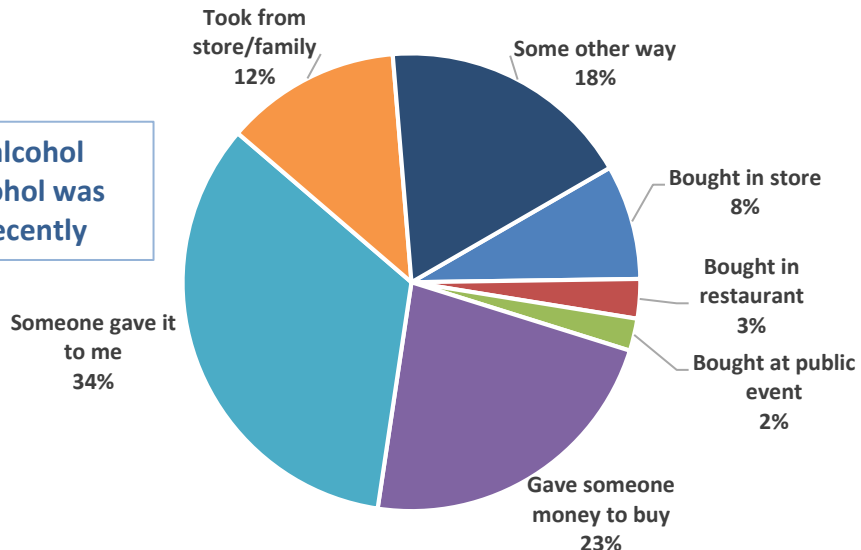

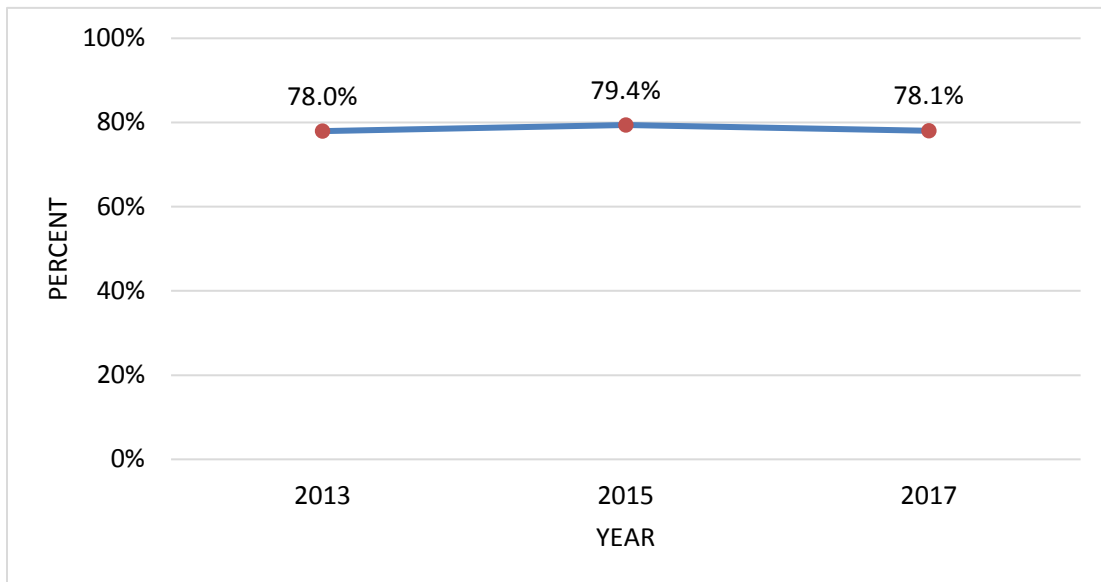

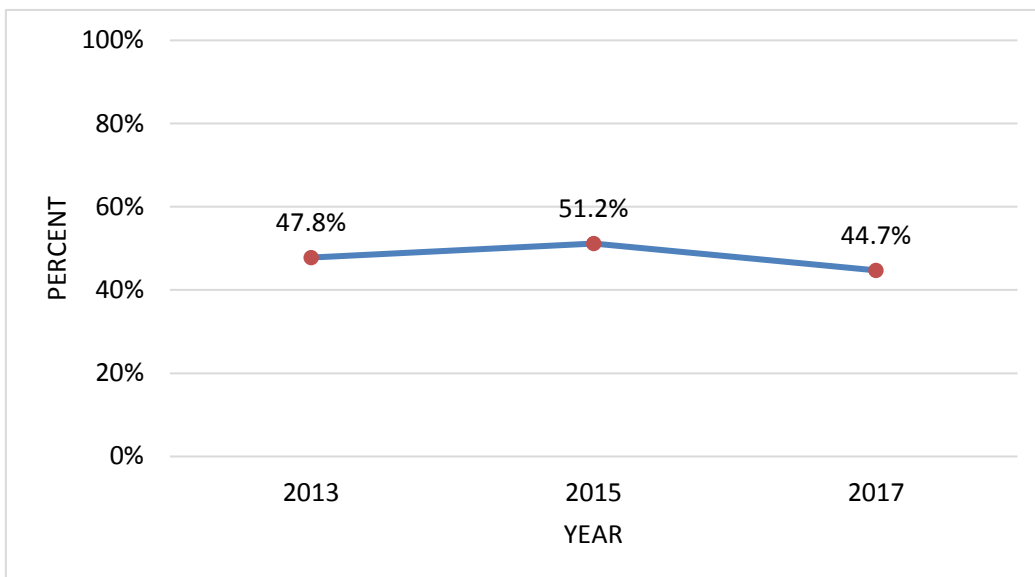

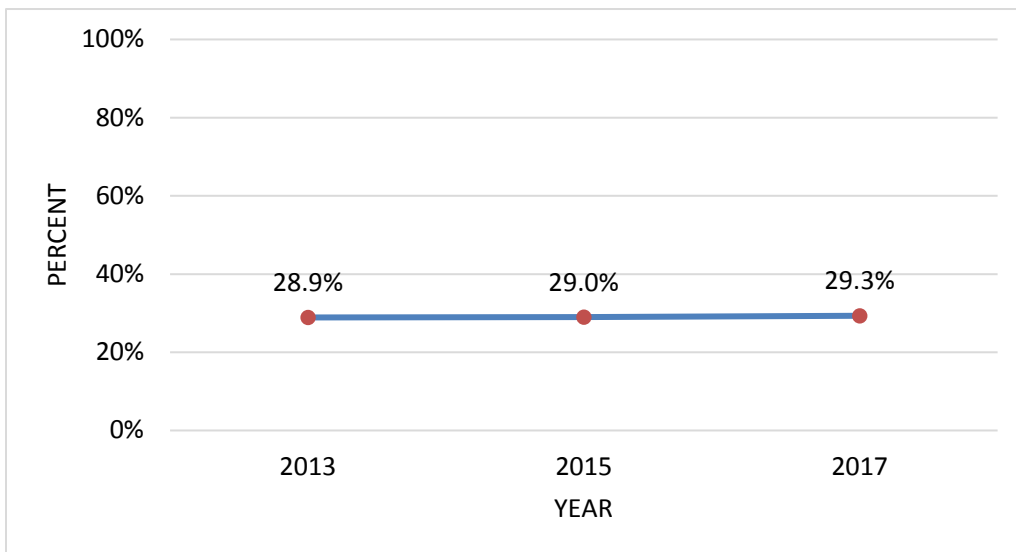

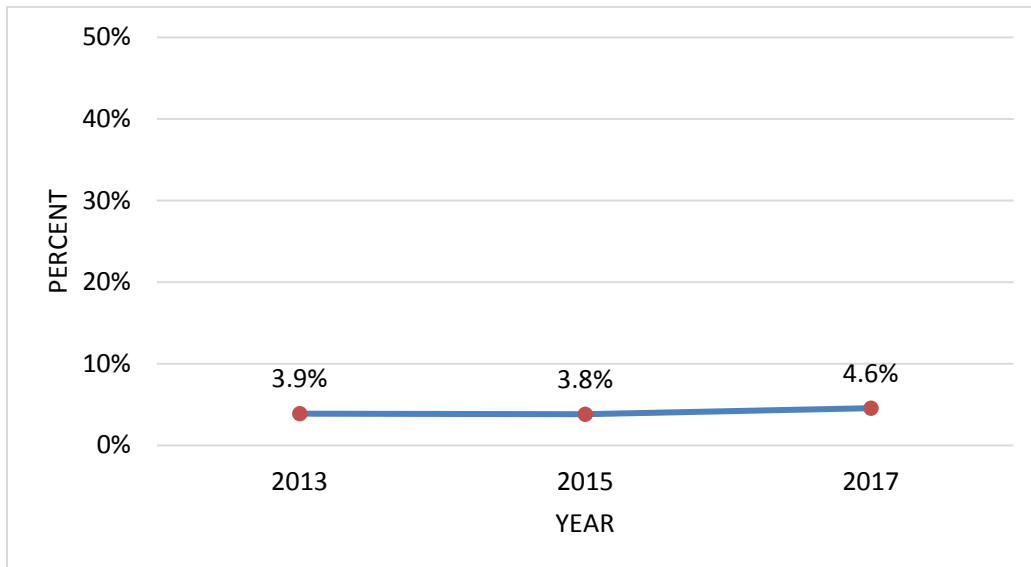

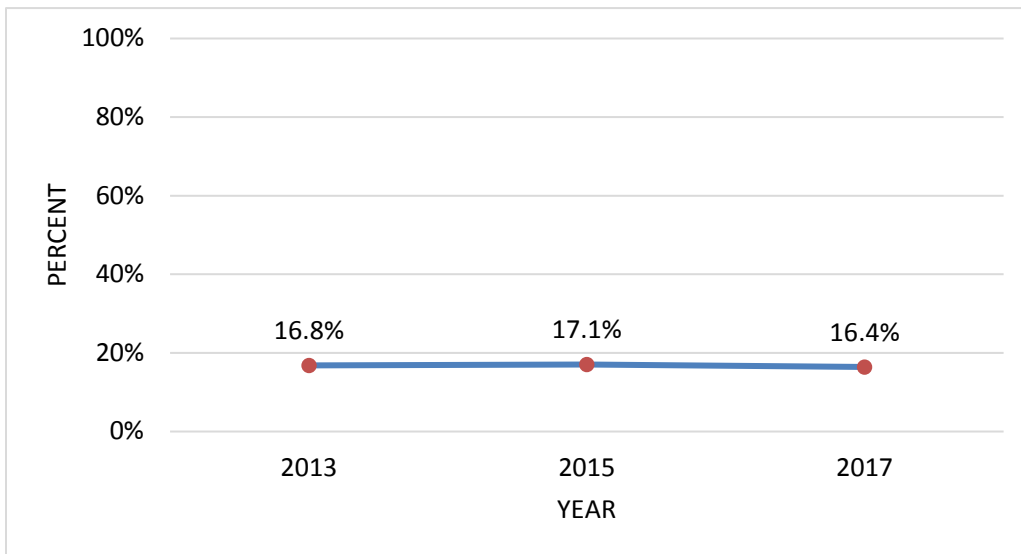

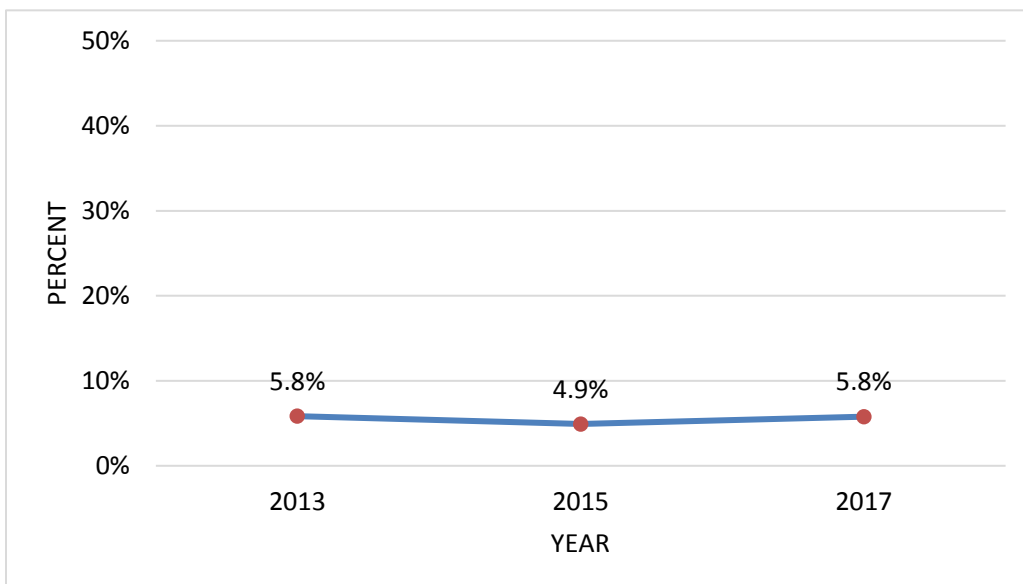

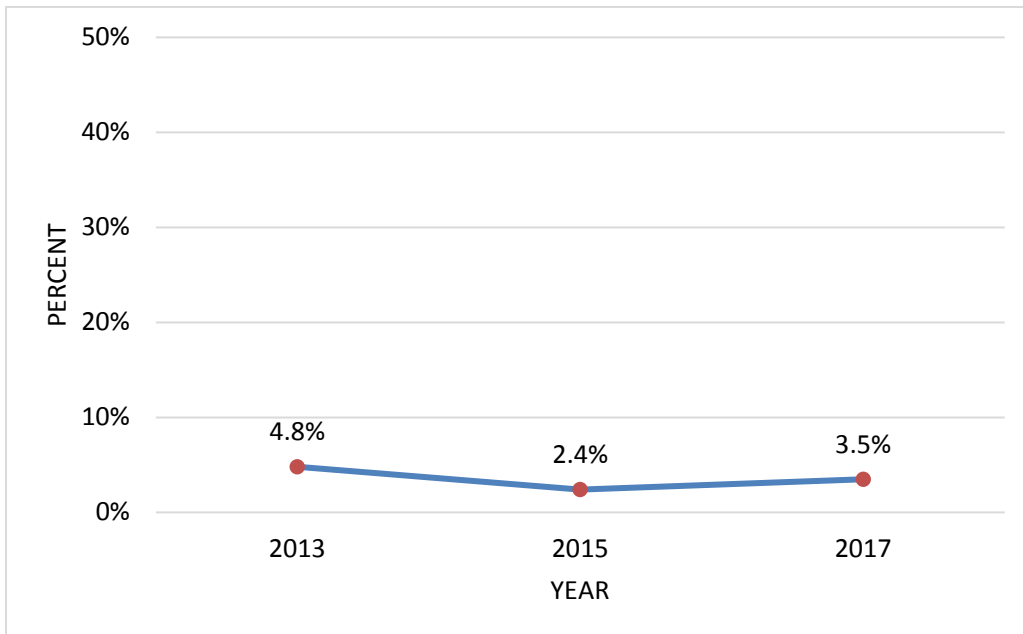

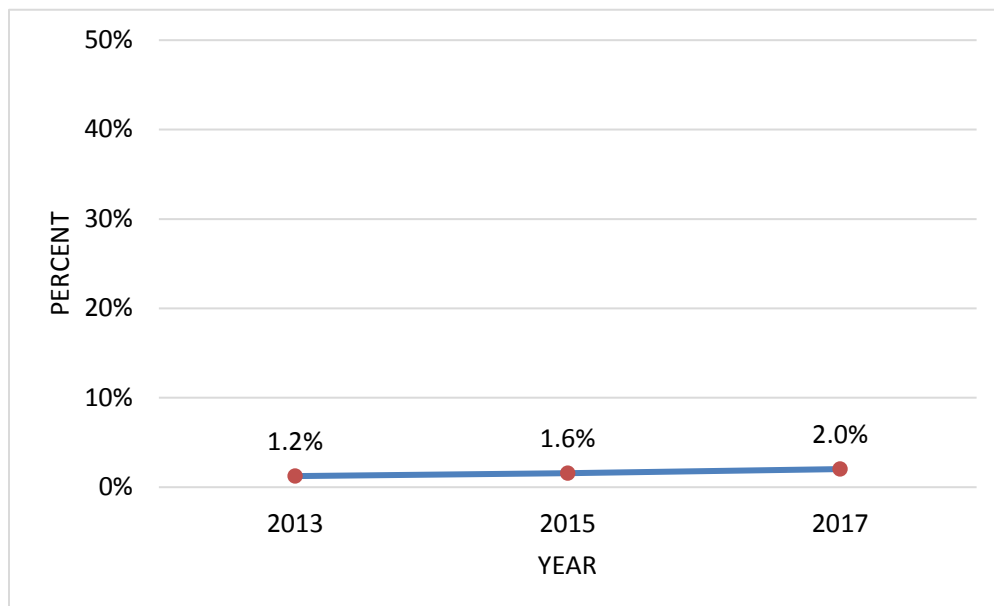

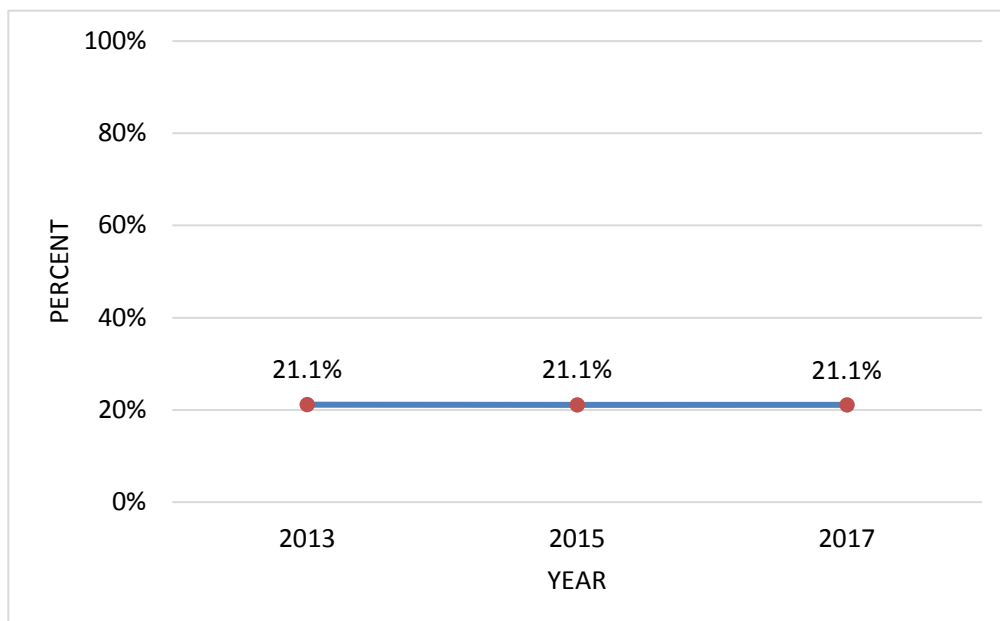

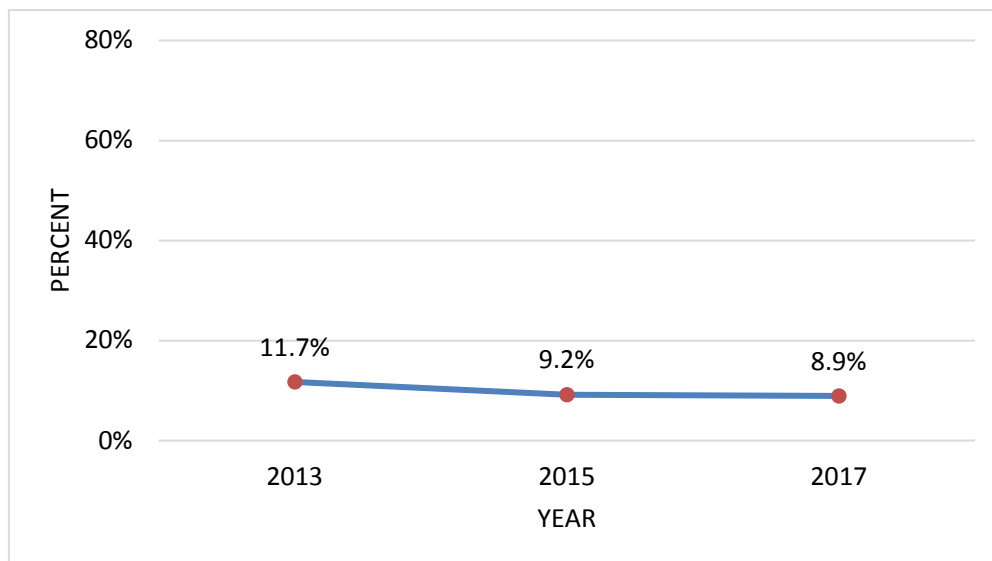

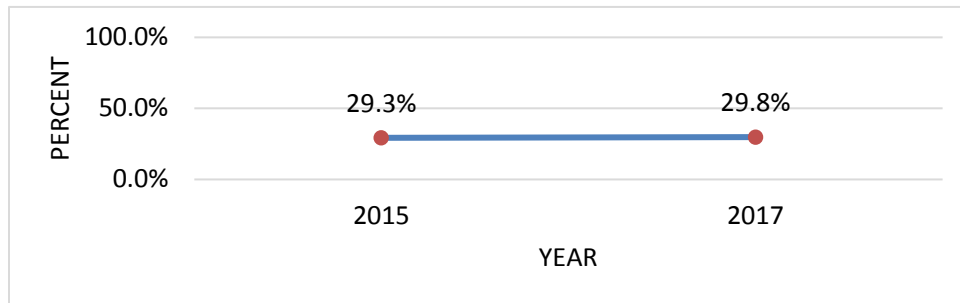

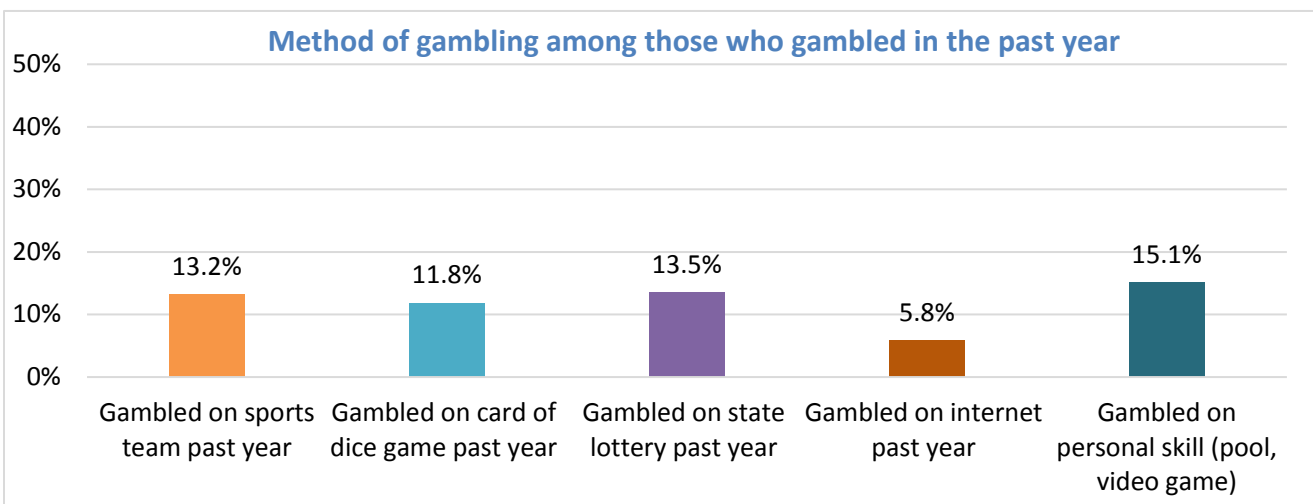

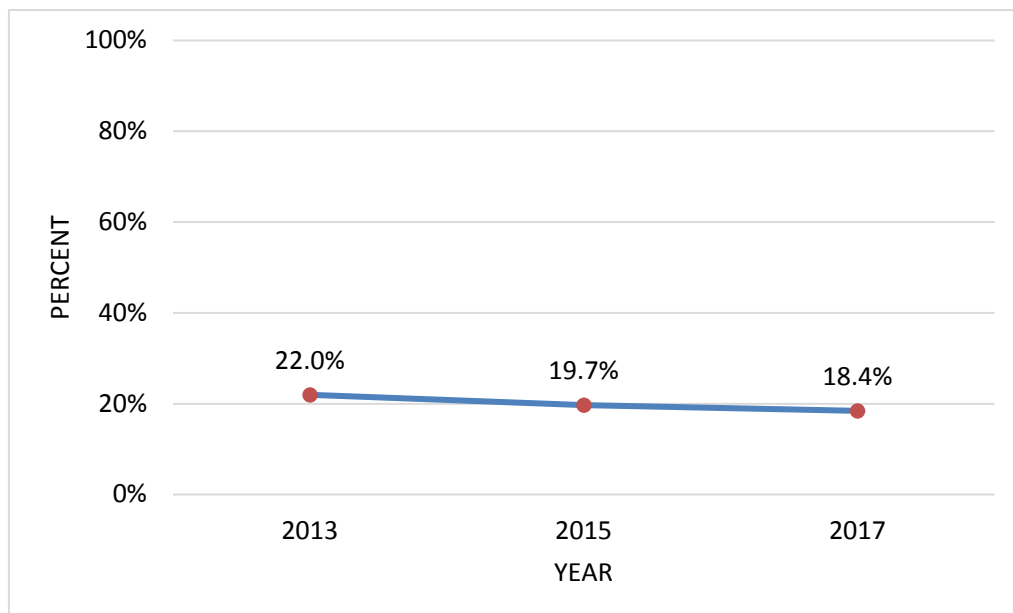

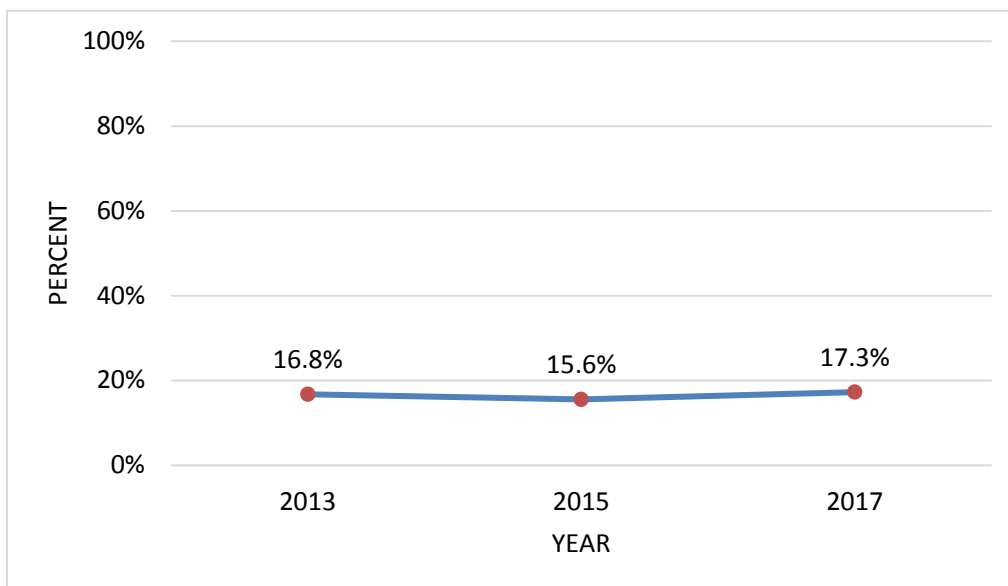

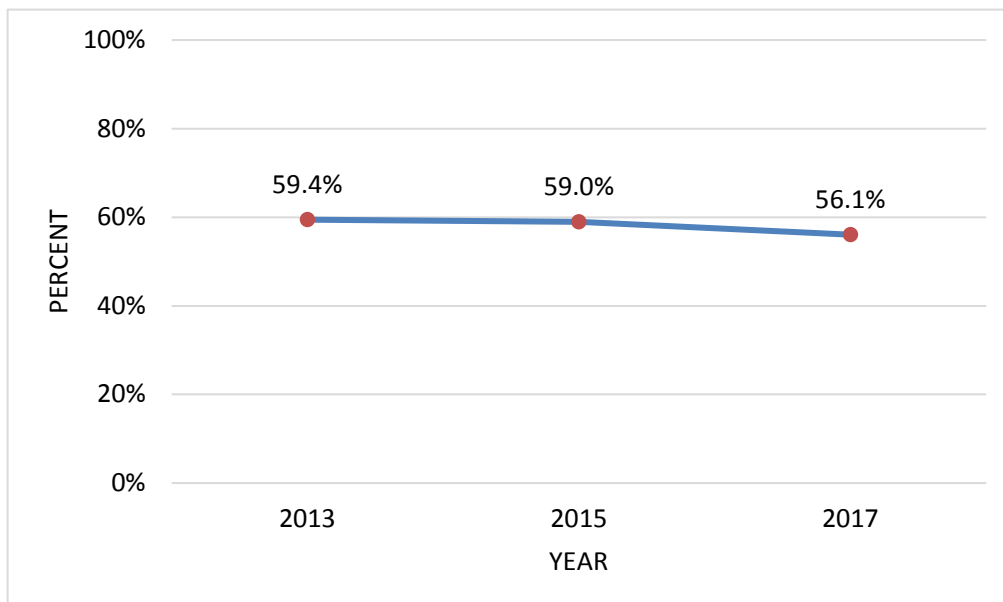

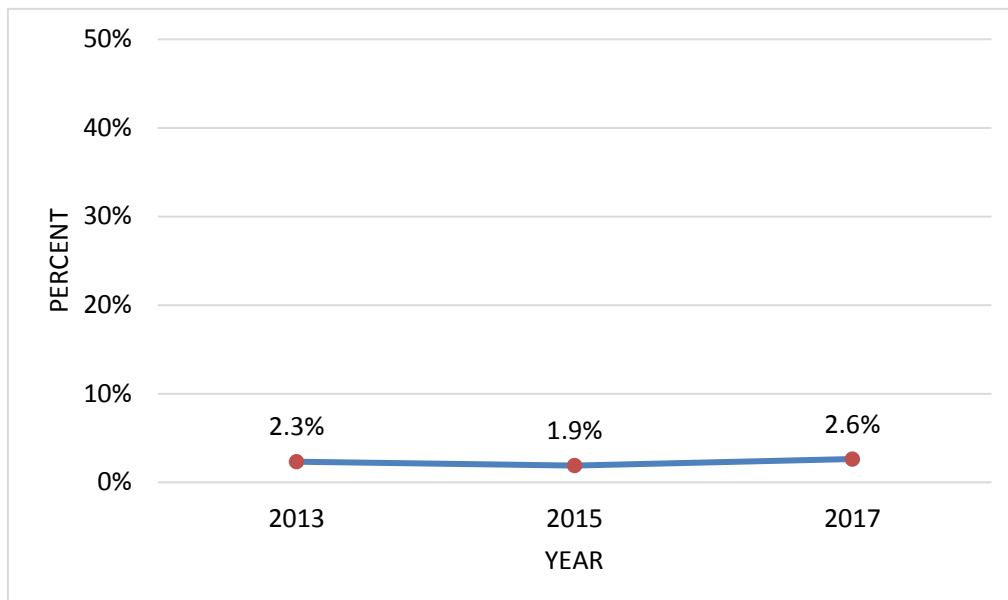

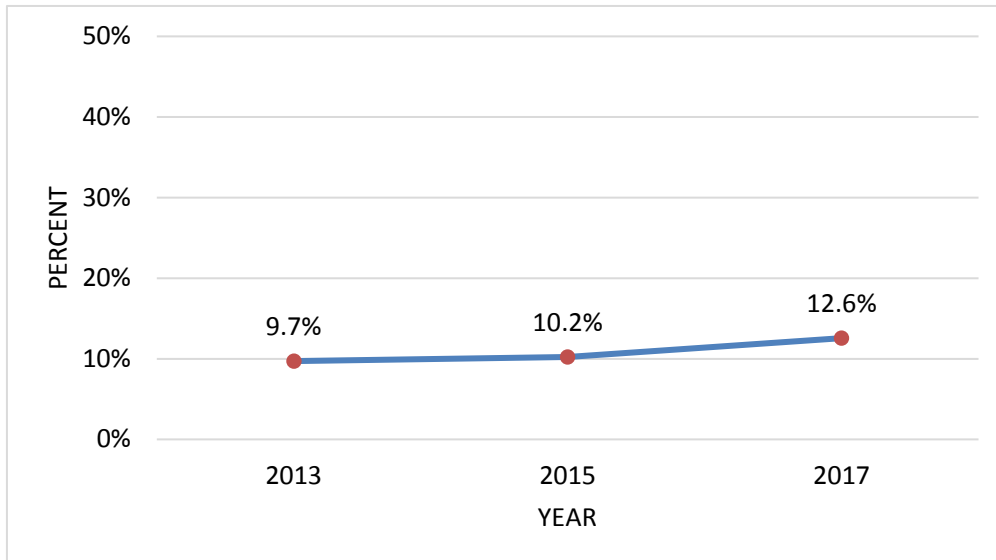

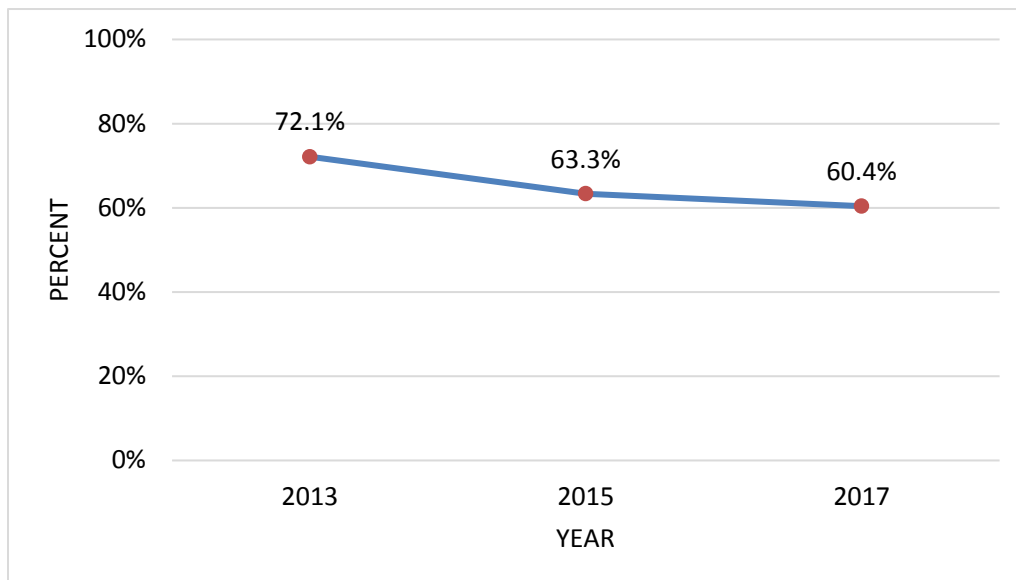

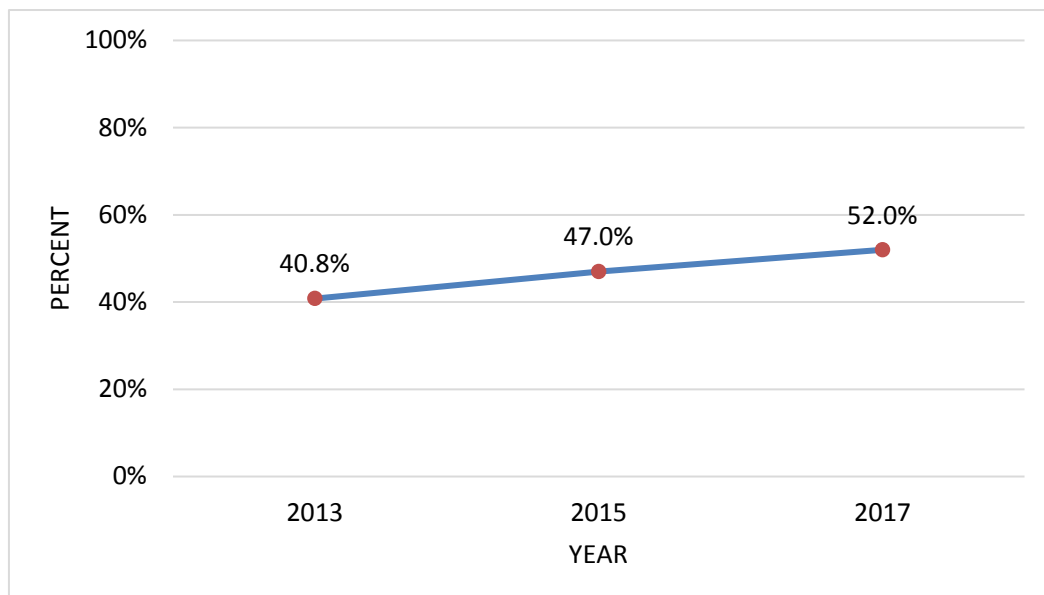

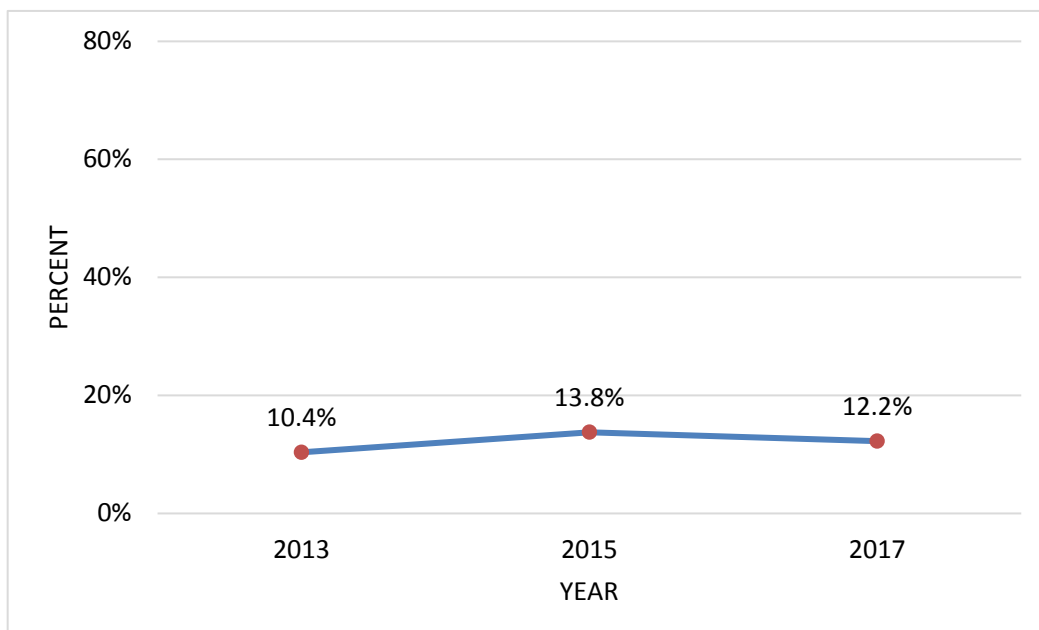

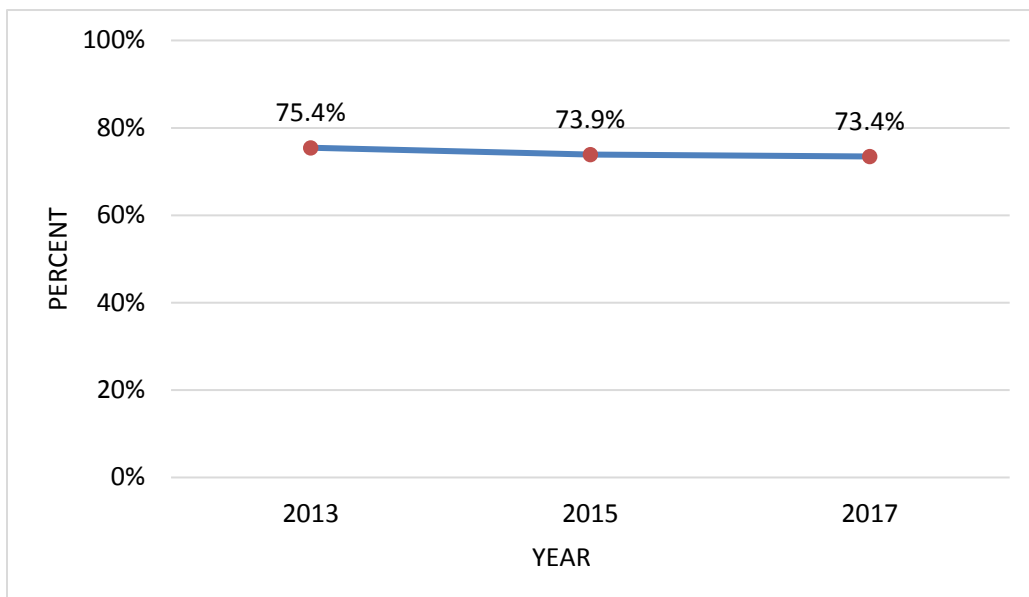

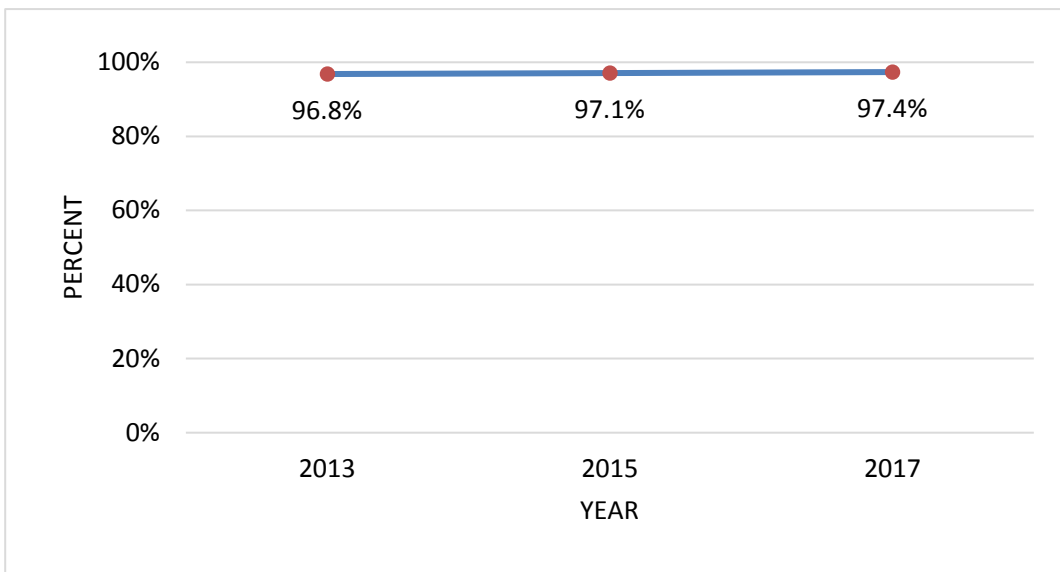

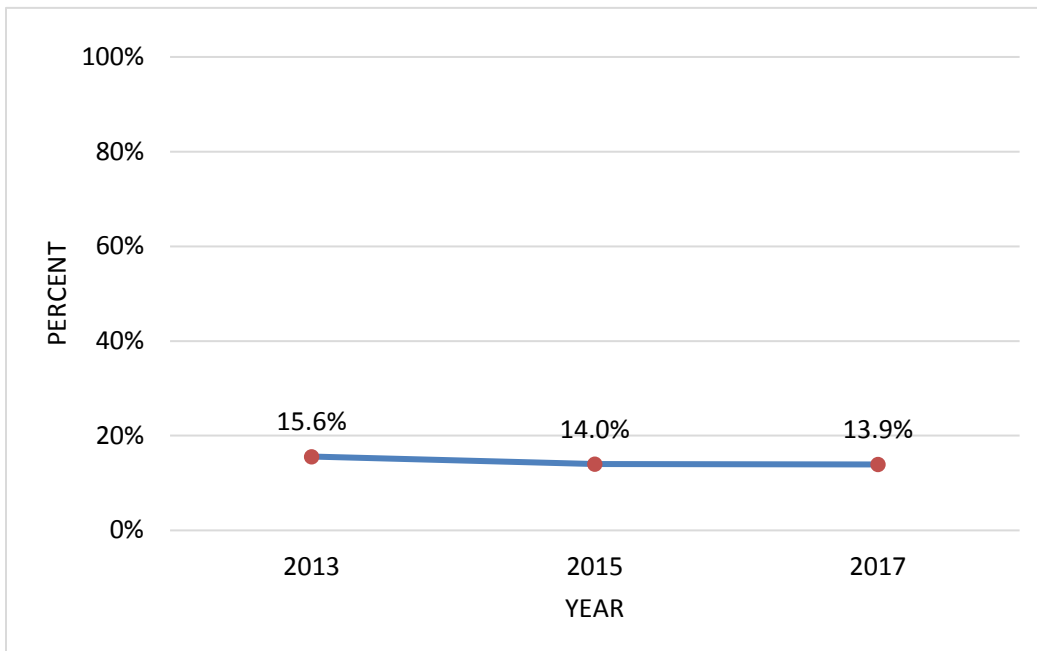

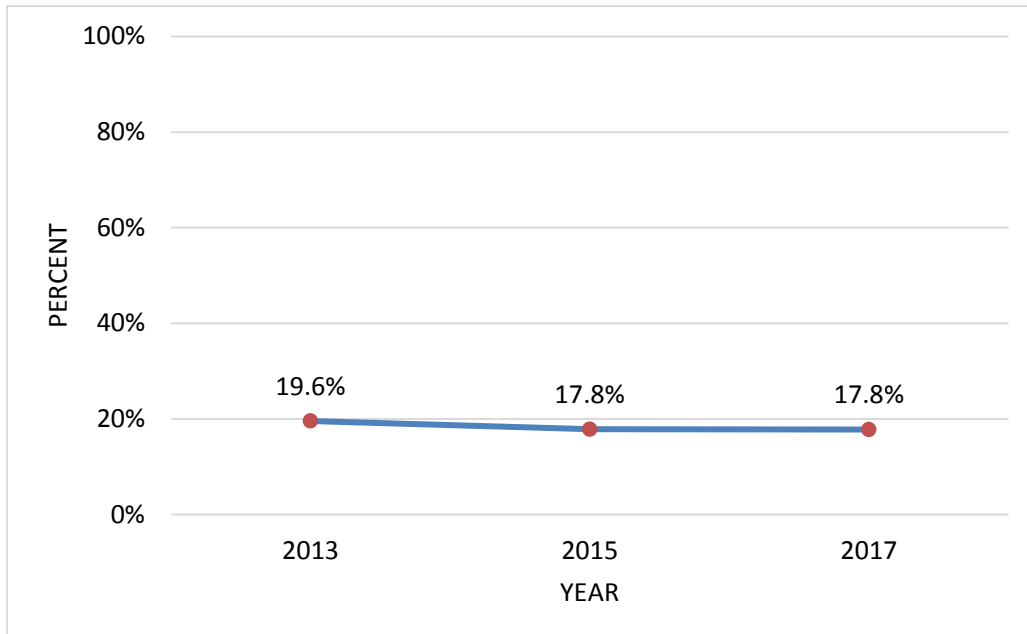

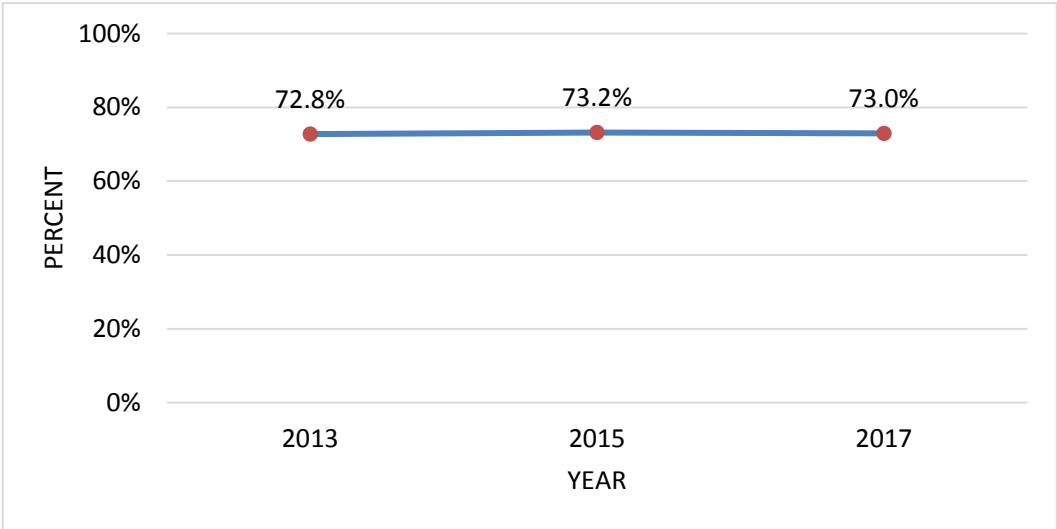

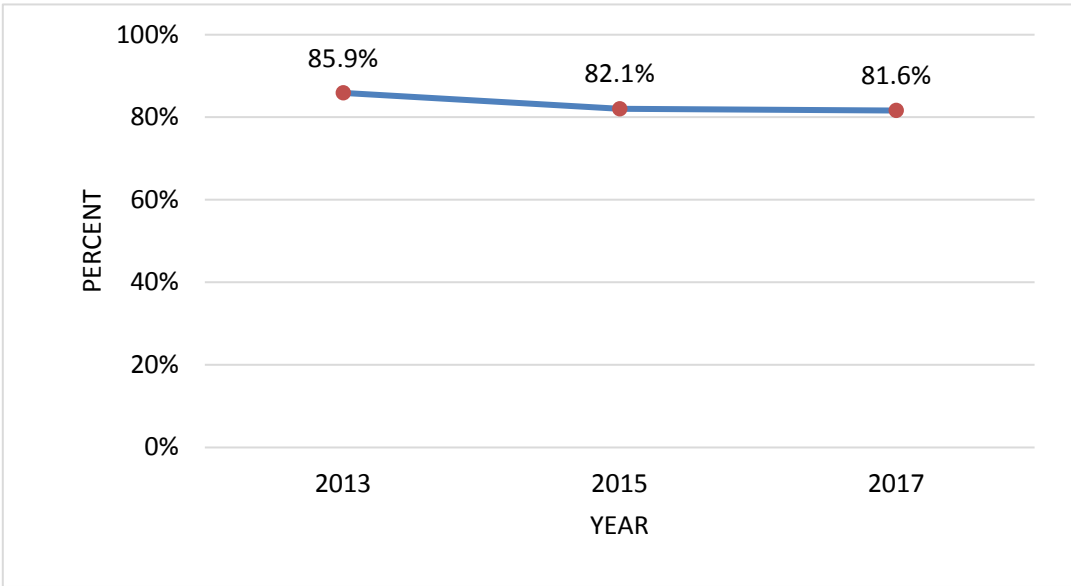

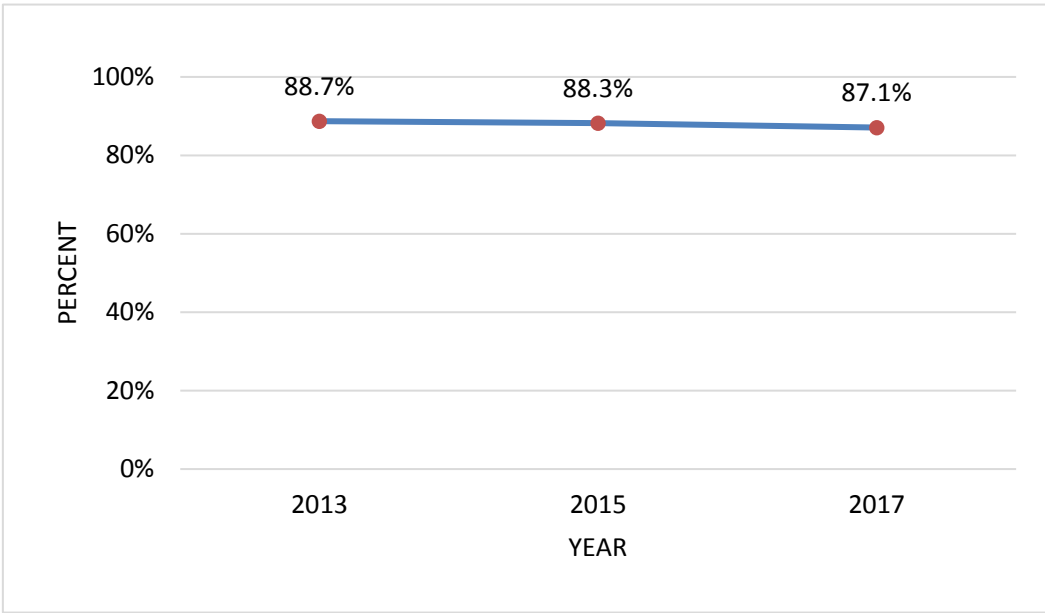

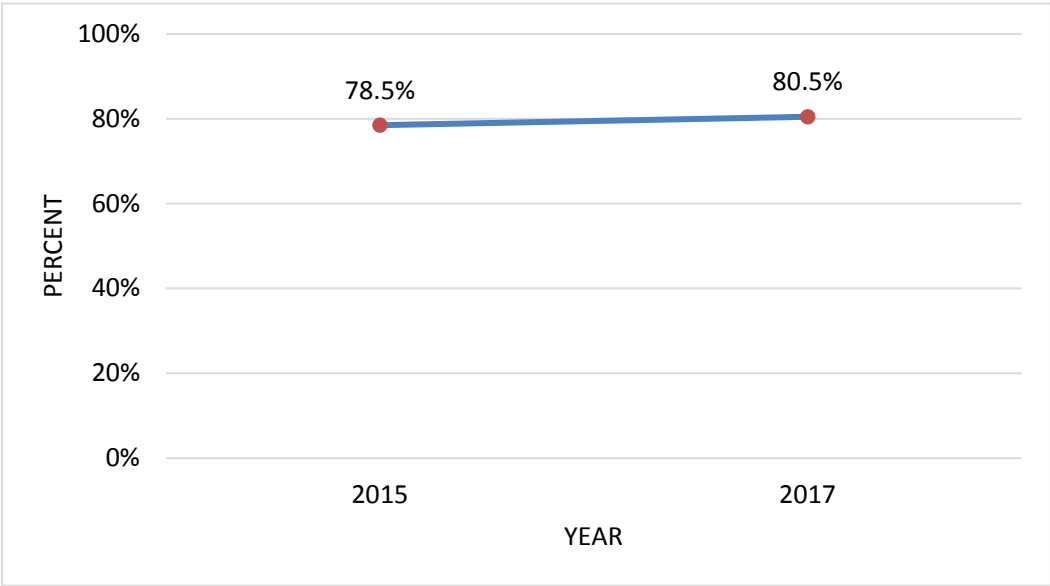

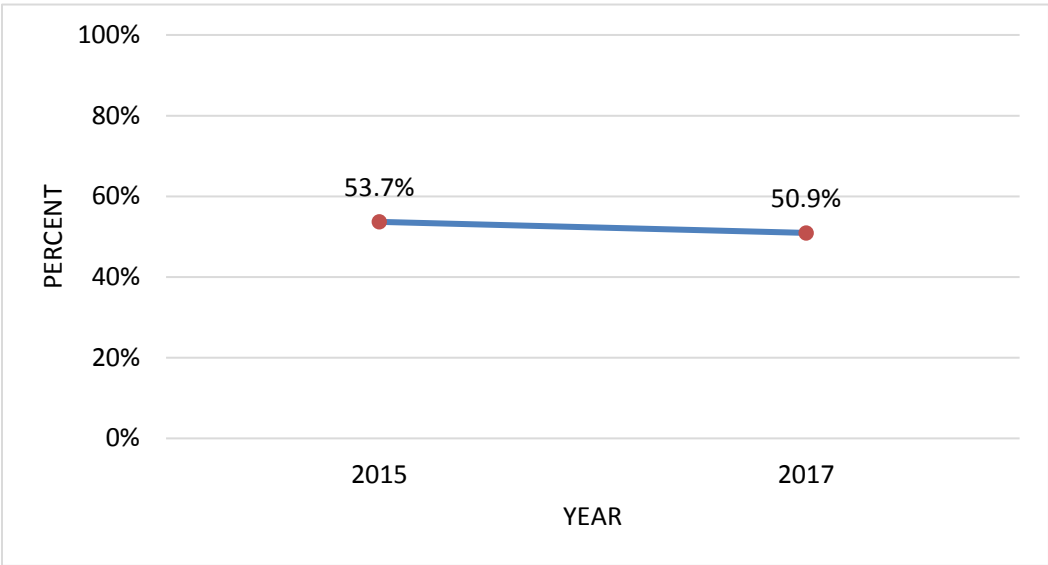

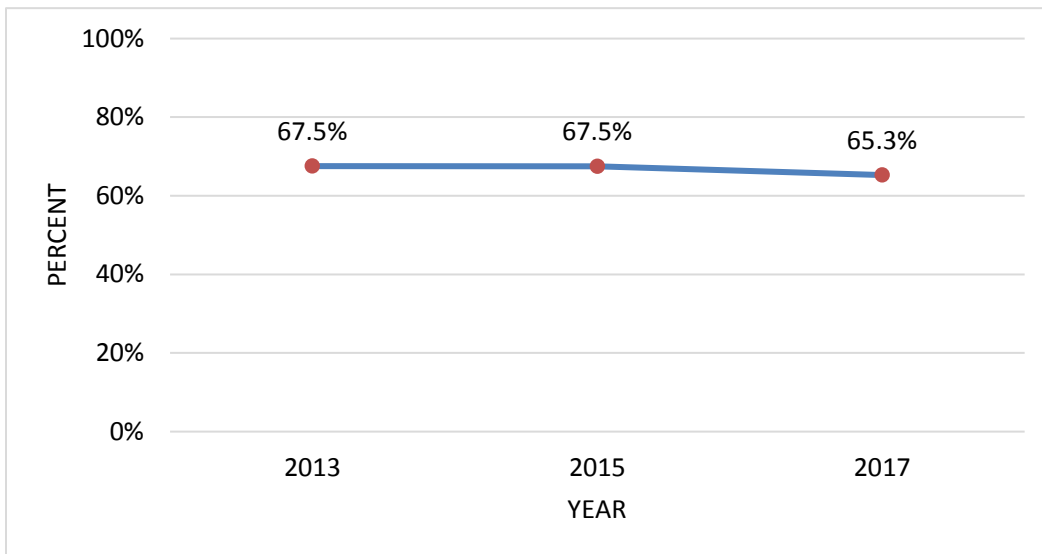

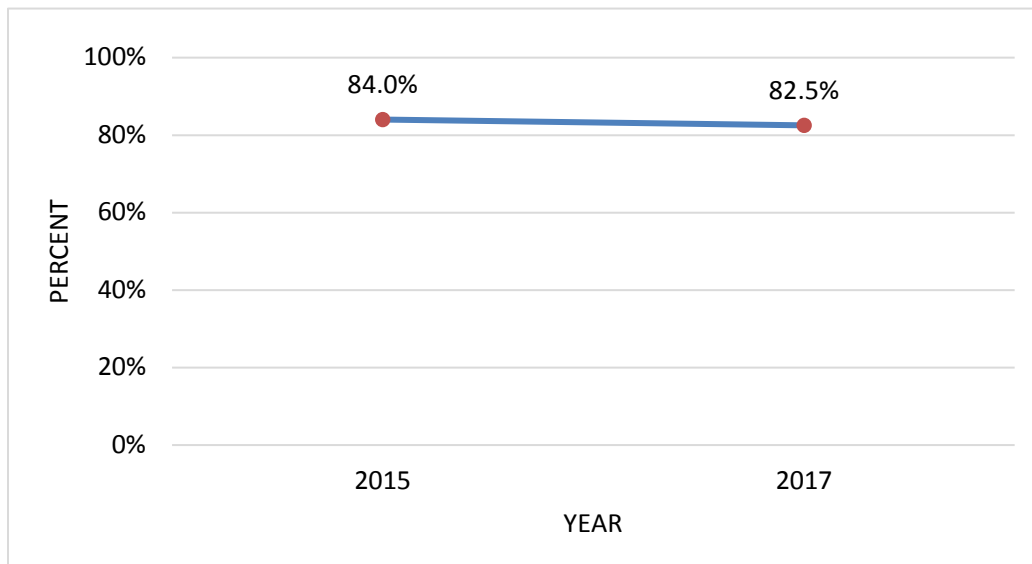

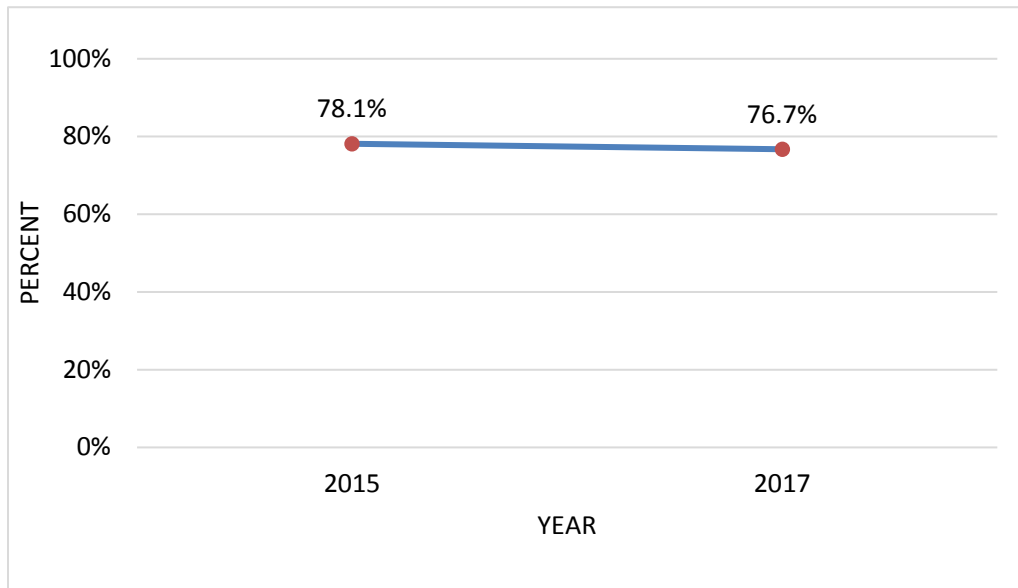

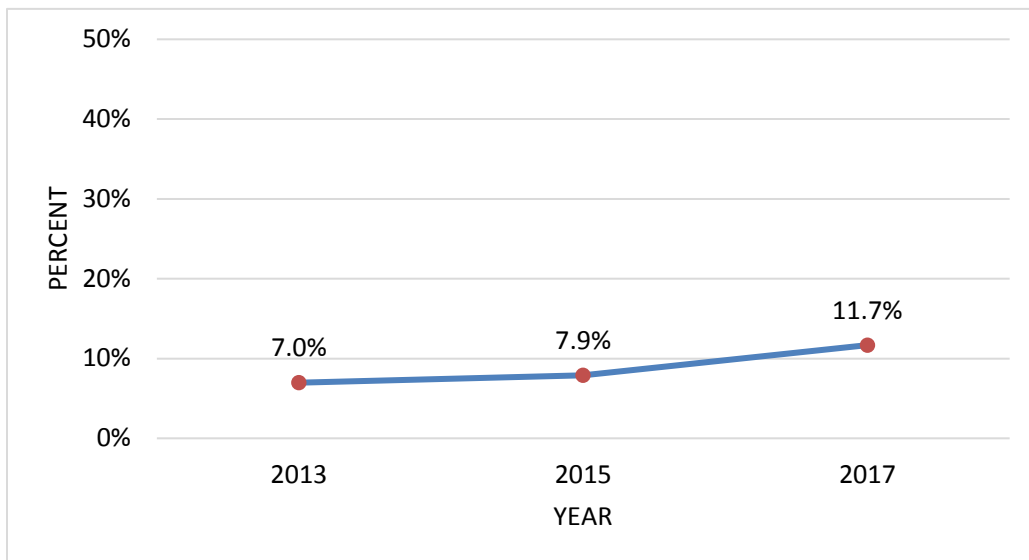
